

Typing Diacritics (accents) in Italian -Macintosh

Typing in international characters is the same for all Macintosh applications, including the operating system.

To produce	Follow these steps
à, è, ì, ò, ù	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Hold down the <i>option</i> key, and type an ` (accent grave).2. Let go of the keys (don't hold them down for step 3).3. Type the vowel over which you want the accent to appear.
À, È, Ì, Ò, Ù	Hold the <i>Shift</i> key down in step 3 above.
á, é, í, ó, ú	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Hold down the <i>option</i> key, and type an <i>e</i> (the letter <i>e</i>).2. Let go of the keys (don't hold them down for step 3).3. Type the vowel over which you want the accent to appear.
Á, É, Í, Ó, Ú	Hold the <i>Shift</i> key down in step 3 above.
