Chicago, Ill., Dec. 2 (Special) -- Otto Graham whose stout heart and strong arm harassed opponents all season and Gene Fekete, a speedy and powerful full-back who touched off a successful title drive, took the lion's share of honors in the 1942 final Big Ten individual statistics which were released by the Western Conference service bureau today.

Graham far out-distanced his nearest rival in "total offense" which is pretty much the key to week in and week out offensive performance. The Northwestern junior half-back in six team gamies gained 862 yards by rushing and passing for a game average of 143.6 yards.

Paul Sarringhaus, Chio State, and Billy Hillenbrand, Indiana, both out-standing half-backs, were the closest players to Graham with gane averages of 111.8 and 111 yards respectively.

Al though Northwestern failed to win a single Big Ten encounter, the Wildcats ace half-back brought his tean close to victory several times while setting up a new high in forward passing. Without a rival in this department, Graham out-stripped the field with a passing gain of 119 yards per game. Len Seelinger, Wisconsin, compiled a game average of but 69.8 yards while leading the Big Ten in 1941.

Fekete, the sophonore full-back who sparised the early season attack of Ohio State and then delivered consistenly fine performances while the Bucks drove to the title, topped the Western Conference in scoring with 52 points and captured the rushing honors with a gane average of 91.6 yards. He was fourth in total offense.

Earl Dolaway, Indiana half-back, punted 13 times for an average of 41 yards to lead the Big Ten. Pass Receiving honors went to Bob Motl, Northwestern end, by the close margin of 36 inches. Motl caught 16 passes for 219 yards while Bob Shaw, Ohio State and was catching 10 for 218 yards. Following are the complete statistics:
