PRINCIPAL INDIVIDUAL PLAYS

List below all scoring plays. List non-scoring plays (except kickoffs) gaining 50 yards or more each, including punts. Under "type of play" indicate rushing, forward pass, interception runback, punt runback, kickoff runback, punt or field goal. Listing of forward pass play should give passer's name first, then receiver, and combined yardage of pass and run. Measure runbacks only from goal line, if started in end zone, as yardage carried in own end zone is of no value to team. All other plays are measured from line of scrimmage (see Official Rules at right).

SECTION 1—FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is **not** recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2—RUSHING.

Article 1: All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, **not** as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.

Article 2: Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.

Article 3: The rushing total is a **net** figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.

Article 4: All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3—FORWARD PASSING.

Article 1: Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to **both** the passer and the receiver.

Article 2: Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.

Article 3: Any loss by a player, apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a **loss by rushing**. He is **not** a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.

Article 4: Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).

Article 5: There is no pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team.

The passer is **not** charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty, under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4—LATERAL PASSING.

Article 1: A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.

(Approved Ruling—Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards, then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving". Player B is credited with NO pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving". Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing".)

(Approved Ruling—Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns". Player B is credited with NO return and with 5 yards under "punt returns".)

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the defensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing". If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5—TOTAL OFFENSE.

Article 1: Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing **only**, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.

Article 2: Total offense yardage is the total of **net** gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving" yards gained are **not** included in total offense.

Reichert kicked off to M1, where ball rolled dead.

UM: Billings punted to Mateja on the P45 and he ret. to the M30, but P clipped ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ somewhere along the way and the ball went back to the M46. Probojewski (afterwards, Probo) made one yard over center. Probo's line buck gained two yards. Samuel's ps. to Kerr incl. Montgomery's punt went to Tinkham and he was hit immediately on the M28. (Purdue made three yards on its series).

UL: Branoff made three yards to the M31 on a tackle play. Kress ps. incl. to Stanford on a "long" play. Kress was tripped up for an eight yard loss to the M23. Billings punted to Mateja on the P35, and he ret. to the M48. (Michigan lost 5 yards on the series)

PU: Probo went over tackle for three yards. Brock was stopped at center after one yard gain. Probo (corr. Pobojewski--Pobo) was piled up at tackle after two yards gain. Montgomery, back to kick, fumbled the pass from center and rec. on the P44 (-12).

M takes over. (P net on the series was -8 yards).

UM: Branoff reversed to Kress and Kress lost four yards to the P48. Balzhiser passed to Perry to place ball on P37 (11). Balzhiser bulled his way to a FD on the P27 (10). Kress, att. jump ps., was brought down on the P30 (-3). Crncic, P linebacker, injured on play. Branoff, aided by a Topor block, circled P Rt. End ~~XXXX~~ to the P22 (9). Kress ps. to Stanford who was waiting for ball on P5 (17), a FD. Stanford was injured on the play. Kress passed flat to Topor for the TOUCHDOWN. Rescorla kicked conversion. MICHIGAN 14, Purdue 10, with 7 minutes, 12 seconds elapsed. (M drive went 44 yards for the TD).

Rescorla kicked off to Brock on the P18 and he ret. to P30.

PU: Schmaling bulled over tackled to P37 (7). Klezek made it up to the P40 (3). Schmaling made no gain, but Mich. was offside, and the 5yd penalty gave P a FD on the P45. Samuel's ps. to ~~XXXXXXXX~~ Brock on the M48 (8). Klezek made no gain through center. Samuel's was hit by Walker, fumbled, and ~~XXXXXX~~ Geyer rec. for M on the P46. (P net yardage was 16 yards). M took over.

UM: Balzhiser made one yard over tackle. Topor ps. compl. to Perry on the P36 for a FD (9). Branoff circled end until run out of bounds on P30 (6). Balzhiser twisted his way over guard to the P27 (3). Branoff around P rt. end. for a FD on the P21 (6). Kress over tackle for one yard to P20. Howell was tripped up on the 20 for no gain. Kress ps. compl. Stanford on P11 for a FD (9). Branoff was run out of bounds on the P9, but pen. ag. M 15yds for Illusehds. Kress ps. incl. Stanford in deep flat. Topor ps. compl. Stanford on P18 (9). Topor ps. to Branoff ~~XXXXXXXX~~ to bring the ball to P4 (14). Kress jumped over tackle to the P3 (1) falling by one yd to make a FD. P takes over. (M series went 43 yards).

END OF THIRD QUARTER.

FOURTH QUARTER

PU: Klezek moved up the center to the P5 (2). Schmaling made no yardage over tackle. Schmaling dove over tackle for two yards. Montgomery punted to Branoff on the M44. (P series went four yards).

UM: Kress made three yards over tackle. Balzhiser reversed to Branoff who was dragged down on the M38 (-9). ~~XXXXXX~~ Kress' quick-kick angled out-of-bds on the P18 (50 yards kick). (M series -6 net yards)

PU: Samuels ps. compl. Klezek to the P15 ~~(3)~~ (3). Samuels ps. compl. Brock on P19 (4). Samuels ran end to the M26 for a FD (7). Klezek around end ~~xxxx~~ lost yardage to P22 (-4). Samuels ps. compl. to Kerr for a FD on the 50 (28). Klezek punched over tackle ~~for~~ to the M43 (7). Kerr, P End, injured on play). Schmaling made it a first down over center to M37 (6). Samuels' bullet-ps. to Flowers incl. Samuels, dropped back on ~~xxxx~~ 50, was pen. to P42 for intl grdg ps. Samuels piled up out-of-bds on M40 (18). Montgomery punted to M4 where ball bounced dead. (P series 47 yds net)

UM: Kress bulled over center to the M8 (4). Balzhiser moved over center to the M12 (4). Balzhiser sliced over tackle to M M26 for a FD (14). ~~XXXXXX~~ Branoff moved to the M35, but 15yd. pen. ag M for offensive holding nrought ball back to M10. ~~XXXX~~ Kress' ps. to Topor incl. Kress ps. compl. to Balzhiser on M17 (7). Heninger, P hb, injured on play. Balzhiser moved to M30, but fumbled to M41, where P's ~~XXXX~~ Gutman rec. (M series went 37 yds net)

PU: Schmaling went over tackle for three yards. Samuels was brought down for a three yard loss. Samuels ps. incl. to Klezek. Samue's ps. incl. to Flowers deep. M takes over. (P made no yardage on series)

UM: Kress moved ball to M45 (5) on center plunge. Balzhiser tripped up on M40 (-5) after pitch-out. Branoff bulled through tackle to M42 (2). Billings punted out-of-bds on P15 (45 yd punt). P takes over. (M series went two yards net)

PU: Evans ps. incl. deep to Flowers. Oldham intercepted Samuels' ps. ~~xxx~~ on P42, and Oldham ret. to P5. (P series 0 yds).

UM: Howell carried over P rt. tackle for yardage up to P2 (3). Howell took ball to one-foot line (1). Howell cracked over P left. tackle for the TOUCHDOWN. (5 yd. series) Rescorla converted. MICHIGAN 21, PURDUE 10 with 12 minutes, 51 seconds elapsed.

A 15-yd pen ag. Purdue on extra-point attempt enabled M to kick from P45. Rescorla ko'd to Brook on 3 and he ret. to P16.

PU: Pobo carried, but 5-yd pen. ag. P for bfld-in-motion. Oldham int. Evans' ps. int. for Herkimer on M47. (P net on this series -5)

UM: Balzhiser over center to M49 (2). Kress picked up two more yards to P48. The game ended before ~~xxxx~~ another play could be started.
