Measure runbacks only from goal line, if started in end zone, as yardage carried in own end zone is of no value to team. All other plays are measured from line of scrimmage (see Official Rules at right).

OFFICIAL RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS

(Issued by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

SECTION 1—FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is not recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2—RUSHING.

Article 1: All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, not as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.

Article 2: Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.

Article 3: The rushing total is a net figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.

Article 4: All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3—FORWARD PASSING.

Article 1: Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to both the passer and the receiver.

Article 2: Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.

Article 3: Any loss by a player apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a loss by rushing. He is not a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.

Article 4: Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).

Article 5: There is no pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team.

The passer is not charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty, under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4—LATERAL PASSING.

Article 1: A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.

(Approved Ruling—Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards; then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving"; Player B is credited with NO pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving". Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing".)

(Approved Ruling—Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns". Player B is credited with NO return and with 5 yards under "punt returns".)

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the offensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing". If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5—TOTAL OFFENSE.

Article 1: Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing only, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.

Article 2: Total offense yardage is the total of net gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving" yards gained are not included in total offense.

Vincent went over right guard for six yards. Reichow tried right ~~gum~~ tackle for five yards and a first down on the I45. Iowa drew a 15-yard penalty for offensive holding. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Wiegmann tried right guard for five yards. Reichow's pass to Smith broken up down-field by Kress. Dugger threw Reichow for a 11-yard loss. Wiegmann punted from the I32 to the M16 to Kress who returned to the M24. Kress lost two yards around right end. Baldacci passed to Kress for three yards. Branoff fumbled on the M₂8 and Jones recovered for Iowa.

Reichow went over right tackle for five yards. Vincent tried ~~v~~left end and fumbled with Wiegmann recovering for a first down on the M14. Iowa drew 5-yard penalty for offside play. Reichow went over right tackle for one yard. Reichow's pass was intercepted by Baldacci who returned ~~f~~ from the M8 to the M10. Balzhiser went over right guard for one yard. Kress passed from his end zone and the ball was intercepted by Fenton ~~z~~ who returned from the M27 to the M20. Smith tried left guard for a yard. Reichow lateralled to Wiegmann who made one yard around right end. Reichow passed complete to Wiegmann and a first down on the M5. Vincent tried right guard for two yards. Wiegmann carried up the center to the M1 for a two yard gain. Wiegmann went in for a touchdown ~~bx~~ over right tackle but a five-yard penalty for illegal procedure set the ball back on the M6. ~~XXXXXX~~ Smith went around right end for six yards and an Iowa Touchdown with 10:47 minutes elapsed. Smith held while Wiegmann's placement kick was good. IOWA 13, MICHIGAN 0. (Iowa TD drive 20 yards)

Wiegmann's kick went to Branoff ~~who~~ on the M2 and he handed off to Kress on the M6 and Kress returned to the M23. Branoff went around left end for 31 yards and a first down on the I46. Hurley was tripped up for no gain. Baldacci passed to Topp for 12 yards and a first down on the I34. Kress' pass to Veselenak incomplete. Branoff was hit for a two-yard loss around left end. Kress made six yards around right end. Branoff's pass to Baldacci was intercepted by Matykiewicz, who returned from the I27 to the I40. Smith tried right end for 14 yards and a first down on the M46. Matykiewicz passed to Smith incomplete, and a 15-yard penalty put the ball back on the I39. Matykiewicz passed to Vincent incomplete. Reichow's pass to Wiegmann was good for two yards. Reichow's pass to Fenton was incomplete. Wiegmann punted from the I41 to Cline who returned from the M11 to the M31.

THIRD QUARTER

Wiegmann kicked to Kress on the M7 ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ and he handed off to Branoff who returned to the M35. Kress tried right tackle for no gain. Kress passed to Topp for 10 yards and a first down on the E45. Kress went up the middle for nothing. Baldacci passed to Knutson for six yards. Baldacci passed to Topp for ~~five~~ six yards and a first down on the I43. Kress tried right tackle for three yards, Hickey tried left end for one yard. Kress passed to Baldacci for seven yards and a first down on the I31. Hickey went over right guard for four yards. Baldacci passed to Topp for 27 yards and a MICHIGAN TOUCHDOWN with 3:59 minutes elapsed. Baldacci kicking, Kress holding, placement, good. MICHIGAN 7, IOWA 13. (65 yard TD march by Michigan)

Dugger kicked off for Michigan to Broeder who returned from the I10 to the I32. Reichow tried right tackle for two yards. Smith went over right tackle for two yards but Iowa was assessed a 5-yard offside penalty. Reichow lateralled to Vincent who went around left end for five yards. Reichow lateralled to Smith for a five-yard loss. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ punted to Kress who returned from the M40 to the M48. Baldacci was tripped up for a 10-yard loss. Baldacci passed to Hickey for 32 yards and a first down on the I31. Hickey lost a yard around right end. Baldacci passed incomplete to Knutson. Hickey lost two yards around left end. Baldacci's pass to Knutson incomplete. Iowa takes over on its own 34.

Broeder went over left guard for seven yards. Rice tried right end for six yards and a first down on the I47. Broeder tried right guard for five yards. Broeder tried left guard for nine yards and a first down on the M40. Moran went over right tackle for four yards. Broeder went over left guard for 12 yards and a first down on the M23. Broeder went up the middle for 10 yards and a first down on the M13. Rice tried right end for no gain. ~~XXXXXX~~ Broeder lost one yard. Moran's pass to Rice incomplete. Rice held and Wiegmann attempted a field goal, no good. Michigan takes over on its own 20.

Cline was dropped for a seven-yard loss. Hurley tried left guard for no gain. Cline quick-kicked to the I32 and Rice returned to the I33.

Rice tried right end for four yards. Broeder tried right guard for two yards. An Iowa offside play put the ball back on the I34. Broeder's quick-kicked for 22 yards. Michigan took over on its 44. Hickey took a reverse around left end for four yards.
