## OFFICIAL RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS

(Issued by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

(Continued from back of Form 347-A)

### SECTION 6—PUNTS.

**Article 1:** Punts are measured from the line of scrimmage to the point of ultimate advance, if the ball remains in the field of play or goes out of bounds. (Note—"Ultimate advance" is the point where ball goes out of bounds, is downed, or is recovered by the defense to attempt a runback.)

(Note—"Ultimate advance" of the punt shall be construed to include also any distance which a receiver of the punt may retreat toward his own goal before attempting to return up field. This interpretation gives greatest benefit to both the punter and the receiver, since excellence of the punt normally is responsible for retreat by the receiver. Thus "minus yards" should NOT be recorded under "punt returns".)

**Article 2:** When a punt goes over the goal line (a touchback), distance of the punt is measured from the line of scrimmage to the 20-yard line only, since this is the limit of the punt's value to the kicking team.

**Article 3:** If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball continues toward his goal line, the punt is measured to the point of recovery or ultimate advance, as defined above. If a receiver muffs a punt and the ball bounds back toward the kicker's goal, the punt is measured to the point of the muff (the point of ultimate advance), and the receiver is credited with a punt return and with the yards from the point of the muff to the point of recovery, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

**Article 4:** Punts blocked are included in "times kicked", and the yardage of a partially blocked kick is included in "yards kicked". If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal, and is recovered by the blocking (defending) team, the yardage is treated as a punt return by the player who blocked the kick. If the ball travels toward the kicker's goal and is recovered by the kicking team, the yardage is treated as a kick return by the player who blocked the kick, but the blocking team is charged with a fumble lost.

### SECTION 7—KICK RETURNS.

**Article 1:** Only the number of punts and kickoffs which the receiving team actually attempts to return are included under kick returns. (Exception—Blocked kicks which travel toward the kicker's goal. See Article 4 of Section 6.)

**Article 2:** The return will be measured from the point where the returning player actually gains control of the ball to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is lost by fumble. There are no "minus yards" under kick returns (see note under Article 1 of Section 6).

**Article 3:** The return of an attempted field goal, which falls short and is returned by the defending team, is treated as a punt return.

### SECTION 8—FREE KICKS.

Free kicks are recorded as kickoffs if made from placement, and as punts if the ball is punted. The receiving player is credited with a kickoff return, or a punt return, respectively.

### SECTION 9—GOALS FROM THE FIELD.

Successful goals from the field are measured from the scrimmage line to the goal line, plus ten yards, since the goal posts are ten yards behind the goal line. The distance of such kicks is recorded only under "principal individual plays" on the reverse side of the Summary. The distance of a field goal attempt is not recorded under "punting".

### SECTION 10—POINTS AFTER TOUCHDOWNS.

**Article 1:** A player attempting a try-for-point-after-touchdown by kicking is not charged with an attempt when a bad pass from center, or a fumble by the ball holder, precludes an opportunity to kick. Such an unsuccessful attempt is charged to the "team", rather than to any individual player. However, if the ball is momentarily fumbled and then kicked, an attempt is charged to the individual kicker, regardless of the success or failure of the effort.

**Article 2:** When a try-for-point-after-touchdown by forward-passing is successful, the receiver is both charged with the attempt and credited with the point scored. When such a try is unsuccessful, the passer is charged with the attempt.

### SECTION 11—SAFETIES.

No individual credit is recorded for any player on either team when a safety is scored. The team benefitting from the score is credited.

### SECTION 12—FUMBLES.

On any play terminated by a fumble, the yards involved to the point of recovery are credited or charged to the player who fumbled, regardless of which team recovers the fumble.

(Approved Ruling—On rushing play, ball carrier of Team A fumbles at the line of scrimmage and the ball travels 5 yards toward Team B goal line, before it is recovered by Team B. Player of Team A who fumbled is credited with rushing gain of 5 yards, and Team A is charged with a fumble lost.)

### SECTION 13—WILD PASS FROM CENTER.

Any loss resulting from an obvious wild pass from center is charged to "center pass", and not to any individual player.

 Michigan's O'Shaughnessy won the toss and chose to defend the south goal.  
 Michigan State will receive.

Branoff kicked off to Zagers behind the goal line.

MICHIGAN STATE--1&10 on own 20. Michigan State offside and penalized five, 1 and 15 on 15. Bolden took a hand-off and Balzhiser stopped him after he made two. Zagers took a pass from Yewcic and Baldacci stopped him on the 21. 3&9 Slonac went around right end to the 25, Balzhiser stopped him. 4&5 Yewcic kicked to Kress on the 27 and ran to the right sideline where Bolden stopped him on the 27.

U. OF MICHIGAN--1&10 on own 27 Branoff took a hand-off over right guard to the 30. Kress ran right end and Quinnlan forced him out of bounds on the 30. 3&7 Baldacci passed complete to Topp who was downed immediately by Bolden on the U. of M. 40. 1&10 Kress went over left guard to the 46, Jebb stopped him. Branoff was stopped by Neil on the U. of M. 48 3&1 Balzhiser drove over right tackle to the Michigan State 49 for a first down. Kress circled right end to the State 46, Jebb and Slonac made the tackle. Kress went over left guard to the State 42, Neil made the stop. 3&4 Wolverines penalized five for too much time, 3&9 on State 47. Zagers intercepted a pass on his own 31 but he was pushed out of bounds on 46, but Michigan State was penalized back to its own 16 for clipping.

MICHIGAN STATE--1&10 on own 16. Slonac, on a full spinner, went to the 21, Balzhiser made the stop. Bolden bolted over left guard to the 31 for a first down, Kress tackled him. Bolden was swarmed trying right end and lost two yards. On a delayed buck, Slonac made but one. 3&11 Yewcic gained four trying to run right end. 4&8, Yewcic kicked to Branoff on the 34 and he ran to the U of M. 37, where several State players downed him.

MICHIGAN--1&10 on own 37. Balzhiser hit right guard and Hallmark and Bullough stopped him after he made two. Kress passed to Branoff and it was too long and Michigan was penalized for pass interference when Branoff pushed zagers. 3&23 on U. of M. 25. Branoff, on a handoff from Baldacci, was stopped by Neal on the 30. 4&17 Baldacci kicked from his own 23 and the ball rolled to the State 10 where Slonac picked it up and Topp dropped him on the State 11.

MICHIGAN STATE--1&10 on own 11. Michigan was penalized 15 yards for illegal use of hands on first play when Bolden made a couple yards. 1&10 on State 30. Bolden drove over left tackle, Dugger made the tackle on the 34. Slonac, on a full spinner, went up the middle to the 37, O'Shaughnessy stopped him. Bolden went over right tackle and Baldacci stopped him on the 41 after he had made a first down. Zagers went to the 45 where Baer stopped him. Bolden hit over right tackle to the U. of M. 48 for a first down, O'Shaughnessy made the stop. Bolden went over left guard to the 45, Balog stopped him. Yewcic's pass for Zagers was far too long. 3&7. Slonac on a spinner went up the middle to the Michigan 38, where Kress and Branoff stopped him but it was a first down for State. Yewcic's pass for Kauth was broken up by Kress on a beautiful play. 2&10 Slonac bucked up the middle to the U of M 34, Knutson made the stop. 3&7

MICHIGAN STATE--3&7 on Michigan 34. Lewis fumbled Morrall's pass and it was incomplete. 3&7. Morrall, back to pass, decided to run and circled right end to the 26 yard line for a first down. Planutis circled right end and was forced out of bounds by Hurley on the 20. 2&4 Buggs took a pitch-out and was stopped by Balog and Knutson on the 17. 3&2. A backfield fumble was recovered by Ellis on the 18. Planutis cracked right guard to the 16 for a first down on a dive. Morrall, on a quarterback choice, ran right end to the five for a first down. Planutis hit the middle for no gain, Morrow was the mainstay in the stop. Morrall passed to Ellis in the left back corner of the end-zone for a touchdown. (19 plays carried 89 yards at 2:44 of quarter, drive started in previous quarter.) Slonac kicked the extra point.

Masters kicked to Kress on the 12 and he was tackled by Kauth and Slonac on the U of M. 30.

U. OF MICHIGAN--1&10 on own 30. Kress circled right end and Lewis stopped him on the 35. Branoff circled left and Matsock tripped him up on the 44, after he had made a first down. Quinlan broke through and downed Kress for a six yard loss. McDonald passed to Branoff and Rody stopped him on the 42. 3&13. Kress dropped McDonald's pass, incomplete. 4&13. Kress kicked Matsock on the 15 and he returned it to the 30, where Dugger downed him.

MICHIGAN STATE--1&10 on own 30. Matsock fumbled, picked up the ball and reversed his field and made two, Dugger made the tackle. Bolden fumbled and Michigan (McDonald) recovered on the State 36.

U. OF MICHIGAN--1&10 on State 36. Dohoney stopped Hickey for an 8 yard loss as he broke past the interference. 2&18 on State 44 Hickey circled left end on a hand-off from McDonald and Babaczewski stopped him on the 39. Hurley tossed a jump pass to Hickey who was stopped by Bolden on the State 31. 4&4 Hickey, on a double hand-off was stopped on the State 30 by Shhiesswohl.

MICHIGAN STATE 1&10 on own 30. Bolden, on a hand-off from Yewcis, made no gain; R. Williams made the tackle. Slonac, on a full spin, hit the middle for 3, Morrow made the stop. 3&7 Yewcis's pass for Duckett, too long and incomplete. 4&7. Yewcis kicked to Kress on the 25 and he fumbled and Jebb recovered for Michigan State on the U. of M. 28. State was penalized five for offside. 1&15. Slonac found a hole in the middle and ran to the 27, Kenaga stopped him. 2&8. Slonac, on a pitch-out, was stopped by Balog on the 24. 3&6 Yewcis's pass for Duckett was low and incomplete. Yewcis's pass for Bolden was over his head and State lost the ball on downs.

U OF MICHIGAN--1&10 on own 23. Cline, took a hand-off and ran the right tackle to the U of M. 44 for a first down. Cline made two at the middle before Hallmark and Jebb tackled him. 2&8. Matsock jumped over the interference and stopped Branoff on the midfield stripe. Hurley ran to the State 46, where Hallmark stopped him short of a first down. 4& inches. McDonald fumbled and lost back to the State 49 and Michigan lost the ball on downs.

MICHIGAN STATE--1&10 on State 49. Matsock carried the ball around left end to the Michigan 45. State was penalized for throwing to an illegal receiver back to the Michigan 40. 3&19 Morrall's pass for Kauth was too long. 4&19. Morrall kicked to Eline who fumbled and Hurly recovered for Michigan on the 8 yard line. The half ended before Michigan could run a play.

U. OF MICHIGAN--1&10 on own 27. Kress ran to the 32, Folwer making the stop. 2&5. Kress ran inside right end, Jebb and Schiesswohl made the stop on the 36. 3&1 Branoff ran to the 37 for a first down. Kress found a hole in the middle and ran to the 42, Jebb made the stop. Hurley ran to the 47 for a first down, Dohoney made the tackle. Michigan penalized five for backfield in motion. 1&15 on own 42. A pitch-out to Hurley lost one as Dohoney and Badazzewski stopped him on the 41. Zagers intercepted a pass for Knutson on the State 34.

MICHIGAN STATE--1&10 on own 34. Slonac bucked through the middle to the 36. 2&8. Slonac on a spinner ran to the 38. 3&5 Bolden, on a double-hand-off ran to the right sideline and then to the 47 for a first down. Topp made the tackle. Zagers hit right tackle and the left side of the Michigan line stopped him on the midfield stripe. Bolden went over right end to the Michigan 46 and Hurley stopped him. 3&4 Bolden ran through the middle and carried two tacklers to the Michigan 40 for a first down. Zagers on a slant went over left tackle to the 34 where Strozewski stopped him. Bolden ran for two yards over left guard, O'Shaughnessy made the tackle. 3&1.
