OFFICIAL RULES FOR RECORDING FOOTBALL STATISTICS

(Issued by the N.C.A.A. Football Rules Committee's Sub-committee on Football Statistics)

SECTION 1—FIRST DOWNS.

A first down shall be recorded whenever the yardsticks are ordered forward by the officials, and when a touchdown is scored from scrimmage (by rushing or passing) within a series of downs starting 10 yards or more from the goal line. A first down is **not** recorded on a touchdown runback, regardless of the distance of the scoring run.

SECTION 2—RUSHING.

- Article 1:** All offensive running plays are to be classified as rushing plays, **not** as "plays from scrimmage," since any play begun with a snapback from center actually is a play from scrimmage.
- Article 2:** Rushing yardage is measured from the line of scrimmage to the point where the ball is declared dead, or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble.
- Article 3:** The rushing total is a **net** figure. All rushing losses must be recorded so as to account for the net figure.
- Article 4:** All gains on lateral passes which originated or grew out of a rushing play are included in rushing yardage. (See Article 1 of Section 4.)

SECTION 3—FORWARD PASSING.

- Article 1:** Forward passing gains or losses are measured from the scrimmage line to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble), so as to include both length of pass and running advance after completion. All yards gained or lost on each completed pass play are credited to **both** the passer and the receiver.
- Article 2:** Loss from a completed forward pass which did not advance the ball to the scrimmage line is a yardage charge against passing gain.
- Article 3:** Any loss by a player apparently intending to pass, but thrown behind the line of scrimmage, is recorded as a **loss by rushing**. He is **not** a passer until he has thrown the ball, and he retains at all times the option of running.
- Article 4:** Interception returns are measured from the point of interception to the point where the ball is declared dead (or is recovered by opponents in the case of a fumble).
- Article 5:** There is **no** pass completed by penalty. A gain through interference on a passing play is a penalty against the defending team.

The passer is **not** charged with a pass attempt, nor credited with a pass completed or yards gained; nor is the intended receiver (or the player interfered with) credited with a pass caught. The passing team is credited only with a first down by penalty. The defensive (offending) team is charged with a penalty, and the distance from the line of scrimmage to the spot of the penalty, under "yards penalized."

Article 6: The forward passer is charged with a forward pass attempt when a forward pass is ruled intentionally grounded.

SECTION 4—LATERAL PASSING.

- Article 1:** A lateral pass is always a component part of the ultimate play, whether it precedes or follows that play, since the lateral is merely an extension of the original or ultimate play, in effect.
- (Approved Ruling—Player A receives a forward pass for a gain of 10 yards; then throws a lateral pass to Player B, who gains an additional 5 yards. Player A is credited with one pass caught and 10 yards under "receiving"; Player B is credited with NO pass caught and with 5 yards under "receiving". Player who threw the forward pass is credited with 15 yards under "forward passing".)
- (Approved Ruling—Player A catches punt and returns 10 yards before throwing a lateral pass to Player B, who returns another 5 yards. Player A is credited with one return and 10 yards under "punt returns". Player B is credited with NO return and with 5 yards under "punt returns".)

Article 2: Incomplete lateral passes are scored as fumbles, and yards lost are charged against the player who, in the scorer's opinion, was responsible for the failure of the pass.

Article 3: Intercepted lateral passes are scored as fumbles, the offensive team being charged with a fumble lost.

Article 4: The official scorer rules on whether a completed pass to a flanker or man-in-motion is a forward or a lateral pass. If the latter, the play is recorded under "rushing". If the pass is incomplete, the subsequent action of the officials reveals whether the pass was a forward or a lateral.

SECTION 5—TOTAL OFFENSE.

- Article 1:** Total offense is the combined result of rushing and forward passing **only**, since these two are the only methods by which legal advance can be initiated while retaining possession of the ball.
- Article 2:** Total offense yardage is the total of net gain by rushing and net gain by forward passing. "Receiving yards gained are **not** included in total offense."

FIRST QUARTER

Michigan won the toss and elected to receive. Parsons kicked off for Washington to Baldacci who returned from the M21 to the M32. Branoff went through his left tackle for one yard. Kress went over his right tackle for five yards. Baldacci's pass to Topp incomplete. Branoff punted to the W48 where the ball rolled dead.

McNamee went for one yard over left guard. Crook went up the center for five yards. McNamee was tripped up for a five yard loss. Kyllingstad punted to Kress on the M17 and Kress returned to the M23.

Kress went over left guard for four yards. Branoff went over right guard for five yards. Baldacci quarterback-sneaked up center for ~~four~~ three yards and a first down on the M36. Branoff went around left end for six yards but a clipping penalty moved Michigan back to the M25. Kress' pass to Baldacci incomplete. Baldacci pass to Knutson was incomplete but Michigan was offside and penalty was refused by Washington. Kress quick-kicked to the W31 where the ball rolled dead.

Nugent went over left guard for three yards. Crook went over right guard for four yards. Crook went over his left tackle for two yards. ~~KYLLINGSTAD~~ punted to Kress who returned from the M13 to the M21. Crook/

Kress went over right tackle for four yards and Washington drew a 15-yard unnecessary roughness penalty moving the ball to the M45. Branoff went around his left end for 25 yards. Balzhiser went up the center for 15 yards and an unnecessary roughness penalty on Washington moved the ball to the W3. Michigan drew a 5-yard penalty for offside play. Branoff went around left end for eight yards and a Michigan touchdown with 10:09 minutes elapsed. Kress held while Branoff kicked the point after touchdown. MICHIGAN 7, WASHINGTON 0.

Branoff kicked off for Michigan to Nugent who returned from the W2 to the W18. Roake quarterback-sneaked for four yards up center. Balzhiser leaves game with injury. Kyllingstad tripped up for two yard loss. ~~ROAKE~~ Roake pass to McClary incomplete. Bridges' punt was blocked by ~~XX~~

Topp and Walker recovered on the W7. Kress passed to Baldacci for seven yards and a Michigan touchdown, with 12:11 elapsed minutes. Kress held while Branoff's kick was off to the side. MICHIGAN 13, WASHINGTON 0.

Branoff kicked off to Roake who returned from the W18 to the W29. Kyllingstad fumbled and ~~XXXXXXXX~~ Kenaga recovered on the W32. Hurley tried right guard for no gain. Kress went around left end for no gain. Kress passed to Kenaga for a first down on the W20, a 12-yard gain. Kress went off left guard for five yards.

END OF FIRST QUARTER

MICHIGAN 13, WASHINGTON 0.

SECOND QUARTER

Branoff was tripped up for a five-yard loss. Kress went around right end for 21 yards and a Michigan touchdown, with 0:38 elapsed. Kress held while Branoff's kick went off to the left. MICHIGAN 19, WASHINGTON 0.

Branoff kicked off to Washington with the ball going out of the end zone. Washington took over on its own 20. Lederman quarter-back-sneaked for four yards. Lederman's pass was intercepted by Kress on the W41 to the W38. Kress passed to Knutson for 13 yards and a first down. Kress went over left guard for eight yards. Baldacci went over right tackle for one yard. Branoff went around left end for ten yards and a first down on the W11. Kress jump-passed to Branoff for five yards. Kress tried right end for no gain. Branoff went over left guard for six yards and a Michigan touchdown with 4:57 minutes elapsed. Kress held while Baldacci's extra point try was off to the right. MICHIGAN 25, WASHINGTON 0.

Topp kicked off to McClary who returned from the W20 to the W33. Lederman passed incomplete to McNamee. Bergh fumbled and Williams recovered on the W29. Kress passed to Baldacci for 14 yards and a first down. Hurley went around left end for 15 yards and a Michigan touchdown with 6:50 elapsed minutes. Kress held but Baldacci's kick was blocked. MICHIGAN 31, WASHINGTON 0.

Fox kicked off to Dunn who returned from the W8 to the M25, a 67-yard return. Dunn fumbled but Houston recovered for a five-yard gain. Sage made three yards over right tackle. McNamee made three yards over right guard. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Sage went over right guard for five yards. Dunn ~~XXXXXXXXXX~~ lost a yard. Dunn gained a yard over the center. Lederman's pass to Houston was caught outside the endzone.

Hurley went up the center for 12 yards and a first down on the M20. Hurley went over right guard for four yards. Balzhiser went over right guard for one yard. Hickey went around left end for 20 yards and a first down on the M45. Kress went around left guard for five yards. Kress tried right tackle for three yards. Branoff kicked off for Michigan ~~xx~~ out of bounds and kicked over again, this time to Nugent who returned from the W2 to the W25. Kyllingstad went over left guard for two yards. Kyllingstad lost two yards but an illegal use of the hands penalty against Washington moved the ball to the ~~the~~ W10. Nugent made five yards through the middle. Lederman passed to Houston for 15 yards. Dunn punted to Kress who returned from the M32 to the M44.

~~XXXXX~~ Baldacci passed to Knutson for 33 yards, and a first down on the W23. Branoff turned left end for five yards. Branoff went over left guard for 20 yards and a first down on the W8. Balzhiser went over right guard for one yard. Kress went over right guard for one yard. Baldacci's pass to Knutson incomplete. Branoff's pass was intercepted by Lederman in the end zone and Lederman returned to the W3.

Nugent gained three yards over left guard. Michigan drew a five-yard penalty for delaying the game. Kyllingstad went over right tackle for one yard. Nugent went up the middle for seven yards and a first down on the W24. Crook went over left tackle for two yards. Lederman's pass was intercepted by Branoff who returned from the W37 to the W6. Branoff left ~~xxxx~~ the game. Kress turned right end for six yards and a Michigan touchdown with 8:20 elapsed minutes. Kress held while Baldacci's kick was off to the side. MICHIGAN 37, WASHINGTON 0.

Dugger kicked off for Michigan to Black who returned from the W26 to the W33. Sage made four yards up the center. Crook went over left tackle for no gain. Lederman lost three yards. Crook punted to Kress on the M28 and Kress handed off to Hickey who returned to the W41, fumbled and then recovered again. Hendricks' pass to Knutson incomplete. Baldacci, back to pass, lost seven yards. McKinley passed to Balzhiser for 14 yards. McKinley's pass to Williams was incomplete. Washington takes over on its own 35.

Crook went over right guard for five yards. Lederman was tackled for a four-yard loss. Lederman's pass to Black incomplete; Washington offside was refused. Crook punted to Hendricks who returned from the M17 to the M37. Balzhiser went around right end for four yards. Hickey turned his left end for 13 yards and a first down on the W46. Hendricks turned right end for 33 yards and a first down on the W13. Hickey turned left end for 13 yards and a Michigan touchdown with 14:44 elapsed minutes. Hendricks held while McDonald's kick was good. MICHIGAN 44, WASHINGTON 0.

Fox kicked off to Dunn who returned from the W22 to the W24. Hossfeld turned right end for six yards. ~~XXXXXXXXXXXXX~~ Roake passed to Crook incomplete. Roake lost eight yards.

END OF THE THIRD QUARTER

MICHIGAN 44, WASHINGTON 0.

FOURTH QUARTER

Crook punted to Hickey who returned from M27 to M33.

Balzhiser went over right guard for three yards. Hickey turned left end for four yards. Hendricks fumbled for a six-yard loss. McDonald's punt was taken by Kyllingstad and returned from the W34 to the W44. Kyllingstad went over left tackle for five yards. Crook fumbled and Stanford recovered on the M45.

McDonald-to-Stanford pass incomplete, but Michigan draws 15-yard penalty for unnecessary roughness. Hendricks turned left end for five yards, and was injured on the play. Cline recovered his fumble for a five-yard loss. McDonald passed to Hickey complete ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ for a nine-yard gain. McDonald punted out of bounds on the W38.

Lederman passed to Warsinske for 22 yards and a first down on the M40. Lederman passed to Warsinske for 10 yards and a first down on the M30. Lederman passed to Houston incomplete. Lederman's pass ~~XXXXXXXXXXXX~~ went out-of-bounds and Washington drew a penalty for ineligible receiver downfield. Lederman's pass to Killingstad gained 15 yards, to the M30. Lederman's pass to Houston incomplete.

Cline lateralled to Hurley who carried around right end for 50 yards and a first down to the 20. Hickey turned left end for eight yards.
