LOCKER ROOM COMMENTS

Assistant Coach Jim Young:

Bo Schembechler's absence from the game was a tremendous blow to all of us. The team did a terrific job under the circumstances. I'd say the coaching was a team setup and the strategy was set prior to the game. But we lost Bo as the leader and who knows how much that meant to us.

I didn't feel any unusual pressure because of my position, I actually considered it just another game because I didn't have time to think about pressure. We felt USC moved the ball better than Ohio State throughout the game and they showed us a stronger defense than we had met before. We made no major adjustments at halftime except to throw more on first down and get Moorhead on the option.

Defensively we tried to tighten our defense and use more blitzes in the second half. I think one of the key plays in the game came when we failed to block that punt in the fourth period. Had we done so I think we could have gone in and scored.

In reference to Chandler: He's the one boy we felt was under-rated, and could beat you in many different ways.

USC played basically the same football that they played all year, but good football teams don't have to change their style of play. Our inability to stop USC from moving the ball and our inability to score on two occasions when we had the opportunity, seemed to be the difference in the game. We told the team before the game we should be happy and lucky that Bo agreed to be examined and is O.K. We told them Bo got us to the Rose Bowl and now it was up to us from here.

Dr. Gerald O'Conner and Dr. Robert Anderson (team doctors): We have no specific diagnosis of Schembechler's condition now. We examined the possibility of an interruption of the oxygen supply to the heart. We found this normal. He was given an electro-cardiogram. It is being kept under close surveillance. To the best of our knowledge he had some type of upper respiratory condition. He is now in St. Elizabeth's Hospital in Pasadena.

LOCKER ROOM COMMENTS

COACH JOHN MCKAY:

It was a low scoring game. That's what I said it would be. Slough was hurt so we played another interir guy instead of a linebacker. Yes, this is my best-ever defensive team. In '62, we gave up only 52 points but this team was more physical and had better athletes.

We are the most criticized 10-game winning team in football history without question. (regarding the national championship:) Texas is undefeated. We never made a claim to it; I made up a plaque and gave it to our team ~~xx~~ last week. I'm smart enough to know what part of the country we are from.

This is a very young team. Sophomore quarterback and young running backs but a mature defensive team. I see no reason why we won't have an excellent chance in the Conference race next year.

I thought we moved the ball well at times but this was a good Michigan defense. Basically they weren't going to score a lot on us. We played very crippled against Ohio State last year. This year we had more people ready. I didn't see us do too many things wrong.

It was Chandler's best game since his injury. Michigan has nearly the same size as Ohio State last year (except at tackles) and they run almost the same type offensive plays. Moorhead is a fine quarterback. Barry played quite a bit because Clarence Davis had bruised ribs.

McKay's first comment when he came into the dressing room was "How's Bo?"

McKay talked by telephone with a President Nixon after the game. His responses were: "Thank you Mr. President, I appreciate it..... (later in the conversation) "If you ever need any bodyguards, I'll send that five to you."

BOBBY CHANDLER: (Named Helms Player of the Game) On the touchdown I was split out to the left. It was man-to-man defense to the short side with the rover over. We ran a hook pattern called Z-Snake. Jimmy had it right there with perfect timing.
