MICHIGAN FACTS

Michigan today opens its 90th season of collegiate football.

Vanderbilt is the first Southeast Conference opponent Michigan has faced since Georgia in 1965 and the first ever on opening day.

Today's game marks the tenth meeting between Michigan and Vanderbilt. The last game took place in 1923. Michigan has won 8, lost 0, and tied 1.

Doughty's 80 yard run was Michigan's fourth longest play from scrimmage in history. The others are Tom Harmon's 96 yard run against California in 1940, Bill Culligan's 85 yard run against Wisconsin in 1944, and Mel Anthony's 84 yard run against Oregon State in the 1965 Rose Bowl. All went for touchdowns. Ron Johnson's longest run went for 72 yards against Navy in 1967.

The attendance of 70,183 is the smallest opening day crowd since 1966 when 58,420 watched Michigan play Oregon State. The crowd is only 1,203 less than last year's opening game, and is the largest crowd to watch a game here since the Michigan State game of last year.

Curtis's interception was his 18th career interception. He tied the Big Ten record as a sophomore by intercepting 7 and broke it with 9 last year (had 1 in non-conference game).

Jim Mandich's two receptions moved him into second place in all-time Michigan receptions. Mandich's 71 career catches are one ahead of Lowell Perry's (1950-1-2) total of 70. Mandich's 71 receptions have been good for 864 yards, placing him fourth on Michigan's career list. He's just 16 yards short of Ron Kramer (1954-5-6).

Michigan's 42-14 opening day victory over Vanderbilt is indicative of Michigan's ability to score big in their first game. The 42 points are the most scored by Michigan on an opening day since 1956 when the Wolverines defeated UCLA in the opener 42-13. The biggest opening day victory for the Wolverines in modern day Big Ten football (since 1934) was a 55-0 pasting of Michigan State in 1947.

Michigan's 42 point outburst today was the most scored by a Michigan team since the Wolverines defeated Minnesota 49-0 in 1966.

COACHES' POST-GAME QUOTES

MICHIGAN--Bo Schembechler

Vanderbilt helped us quite a bit, but overall we didn't play a great game. It was pretty good for an opener I guess. We're not that much better than Vanderbilt as the score might indicate.

Moorhead is going to be all right. We didn't pass much with Moorhead because we felt we were bigger and stronger than Vanderbilt and didn't have to throw.

I felt we did pretty well with our four-man rush. We did a real good job on containing their option.

We intended to run Doughty a lot because he needs the work. Outside of the long run, he wasn't really that outstanding.

(Mike) Keller and (Al) Carpenter did a pretty good job stepping in as sophomores. The secondary played well and you can always count on (Tom) Curtis to be good for one (interception), can't you?

I called a lot of the plays today and the reason was that we change formations a lot and there are a lot of options on the formations.

I felt the pressure was off when (Marty) Huff ran into the end zone.

VANDERBILT--Bill Pace

I would call this a good old-fashioned country licking. I think Bo and his staff did a great job of getting their football team ready for an opening game. They kept the mistakes to a minimum and just beat us in every phase of the game. I was very impressed with the entire Michigan football team.

I don't think the Turf had anything to do with the 42-14 outcome.

I was disappointed in our play, but I did think that we might get back in it after our score in the third quarter but we just couldn't put anything together.

(The 42 points scored by Michigan were the most points scored on a Bill Pace-coached team.)
