GAME FACTS FOR "M"-Wisconsin

Attendance 87, 723

Ed Shuttlesworth now is the fourth leading all-time ball carrier in Michigan history with 1976 yards.

This was the 33rd meeting between Wisconsin and Michigan in a series dating back to 1892. Michigan holds a 25-7-1 edge.

Michigan has not lost a Homecoming game since being defeated by Indiana in 1967, 20-27.

Michigan had a string of 14 score periods going before Wisconsin broke the strin_ on a 65-yard pass play from Bohlig to Novak to Marek.

Gil Chapman had 92 yards rushing in the first half before suffering a muscle injury that sidelined him for the second half. He gained 117 yards last week against Michigan State.

The 46 yard touchdown pass from Franklin to Seal was the longest for the Wolverines this season.

The 523 total yards was the highest Michigan has posted in a single game this season.

Jim Czirr from St. Joseph, Mich., started at center. He is the third player to start at that position for Michigan this season
