GAME NOTES

\*\*Bill Kay's first quarter interception this afternoon was his fourth of the season. The junior leads the team in interceptions.

\*\*For the third consecutive season under Jim Young, Purdue set a single-season attendance record. The 69,829 that passed through the Ross-Ade turnstiles today brought the season total to 413,794, bettering last year's mark of 373,504. Purdue averaged 68,966 per home game this season, surpassing last fall's average crowd of 68,019, setting another record. The Boilermakers played before ~~an~~ over-capacity crowds in five of their six Ross-Ade dates. Wisconsin (65,002) was the exception.

\*\*Junior tight end Dave Young caught a pass in his 28th consecutive game today. The Akron, Ohio product, a high school teammate of Michigan tight end Doug Marsh, has now caught a pass in every Purdue game beginning with 1977, ~~with~~ with the exception of the 1977 Ohio State game.

Kay made his fifth interception of the season in the second quarter.

\*\*Purdue senior linebacker Kevin Motts had started 32 consecutive games before being sidelined with a knee injury today. The Boilers' all-time leading tackler has made 36 total career varsity starts.

\*\*Mark Herrmann's ~~the~~ third quarter touchdown sneak was the second touchdown of his Purdue career. The first came in last year's Peach Bowl.

\*\*Kay became the eighth man in Purdue history to make three interceptions in one game when he intercepted Michigan Quarterback John Wangler for the third time in the third ~~qu~~ quarter. The record is four set by Paul Beery against Wisconsin in 1976.

\*\*Bryan Virgil had connected on all 30 of his extra point attempts for Michigan this season before missing in the third quarter today.

\*\*~~With~~ senior placekicker John Seibel's 29-yard field goal in the fourth quarter today was his first career three-~~point~~pointer, ~~he~~ after three previous misses.

\*\*Purdue has now won 12 consecutive games in Ross-Ade Stadium. The record is 13, set between 1967 and 1970.

\*\*Today's Michigan loss, together with the Wolverines' opening game 12-10 loss to Notre Dame, represent the first ~~in~~ time a Michigan team has lost two regular season games since 1969 when Missouri and Michigan State beat the Wolves. 1969 was Bo Schembeckler's first year at Michigan.
