FROM MICHIGAN HEAD COACH GLENN E. "BO" SCHEMBECHLER:

"We just gave them the ball game. We handed it to them. I repeat...we did not lose, we gave it away.

"Let's don't talk about the weather. It was bad in the first half, not too bad in the second and we both had to play under the same conditions.

"I am upset because Ohio State's linebacker (Marcus Marek) was permitted to jam our quarterback's count which upset our rhythm and timing. We knew about it before the game because we had seen it on film and I mentioned it to the officials before the game and at halftime, but no action was taken. It is definitely a violation of the rules and the penalty should have been for unsportsmanlike conduct.

"Our offense was streaky, but we still should have been good enough to get the ball in the end zone. Except for the second quarter when Ohio State really moved the football on us, our defense really did not play too badly.

"You are right...our quarterback Smith did not play well today. He had some good third down conversions, but overall his performance was not great. However, I never want to blame any misfortune on any one player.

"We came in here feeling we could move the ball on Ohio State. We did at times, but our turnovers just gave it away.

"No, the loss does not give us a bad taste going into the Rose Bowl. In fact we have not been thinking Rose Bowl at all and the first plan has not been made. And this week all we worked on was to win this football game. Let me repeat... we did not lose, we simply gave it away."

FROM OHIO STATE HEAD COACH EARLE BRUCE:

"I feel very, very good right now. I feel that our football team played about as well as they can possibly play. They gave great effort out there today. There's no doubt there was intensity in the hearts of the Ohio State football players. There was also a lot of great hitting. We played 60 minutes of football today. This is the final step in this comeback we talked about.

"Can you imagine how Mike Tomczak came back these last six games? It's a great credit to a fine young man and a great credit to Marcus Marek, Tim Spencer, Gary Williams, Glen Cobb, Joe Lukens and Jerome Foster (OSU captains).

"You saw a lot of great effort out there today on the part of the Buckeyes. It was a great team effort. I was never so proud of a team in all my life, the way they played today. Defensively I thought Marcus Marek was outstanding. I think if you check the record, he has intercepted a pass in all four Michigan games he has played in. Another guy I thought was outstanding was Rowland Tatum. It was his birthday today and did he play like it was his birthday.

on the Rose Bowl: "Well, it's kind of disappointing, I guess (not going to the Rose Bowl). I don't feel bad for myself. I feel bad for our football players. What the heck. There's nothing we can do about that. We knew we had to win them all and we did not do that. We came up percentage points short. I wish they could have counted the Baylor game as a league game.

on playing in the Holiday Bowl: "If we're going, that's great. I presume we're going to be playing a passing football team again. We ought to be ready for them, coming out of the Big Ten."
