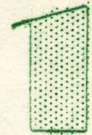

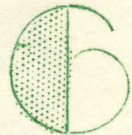

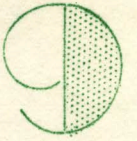

COACH: Bo Schembechler

"As they do, we point for this game. We still, in the back of our minds, are naive enough to think of the championship."

Response to question on embarrassing Perles: "I didn't try to embarrass him at all. We we got dominant, we could substitute at will. What I felt would happen, did...to commit their secondary to the run."

"Imagine the enormous pressure that kid (Brown) was under in a game of this caliber. It behooved us if we could keep him from getting the ball to Turner. We put a little more pressure on Brown. We did stunt a little bit to get after him."

Response to question on comparing programs: "I don't intend to discuss the programs. I'm just an old SOB trying to cope."

On injuries: "My linebacker situation is not good. It's very, very scary."

On future of two suspended players: "I MADE the decision--they're suspended."

Running Back Kerry Smith: "I'm kind of surprised we beat them as easy as we did. I'd say we were pretty sky high. Bo wanted this game real bad."

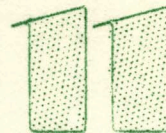
QB Steve Smith: "I didn't expect we'd run the ball as well as we did. Things seemed to fall our way early. They played hard the whole game. Things just kept on working. "

We got whipped fair and square. We got beaten by a better football team. We got beaten at home. We got beaten by the rules. I told them (the players) exactly what I told you (reporters). It's bad for the players, the university and everybody connected with it. I don't make any excuses. If anybody wants to point fingers, point 'em at George.

(Was MSU outcoached?) Anytime you lose, I think you are outchached and outplayed. They stopped us because they are better. I think it was their (Michigan's) best performance this year. (QB) Clark had a lot of people in his face. He did the best he could under the circumstances. None of us coaches or players had a great game. I think I can feel the way Biggie must have felt in 1947. Anytime we have had the backing we have had from the administration, from the alumni and from the students, you feel very obligated to them.

(Regarding talk with Bo Schembechler) I told him congratulations, that he had a very good team and the best of luck the rest of the season. He was very complimentary.

We made a lot of mistakes. Coach Schembechler had a good plan coming into the game. We had a chance. I honestly feel we had a chance. But we're all ashamed and feel we shouldn't have been blown out.

QB Clark Brown

A couple of times I probably left the pocket too soon, ran out too early but this loss is just like any other. We have to come out next week, pick up the pieces, go out and win our next game. They play a lot of tough coverages and rush pretty good. It confused me a little bit. They're a tough team, no doubt about it.

I didn't execute the way I should. That was my main problem. I had time to throw but I missed some receivers.

SE Darryl Turner

This doesn't do anything to ruin the season. This game isn't going to get me down or the rest of the team down. We can still win in the Big Ten. Nothing we did this year has been wasted -- win, lose or tie. We're going to keep working. Eventually good things will start happening for us.

*** GAME NOTES ***

TEAM CAPTAINS-- Carl Banks for Michigan State and John Lott and Stefan Humphries for Michigan.

SERIES RIVALRY-- Michigan now leads the series 50-21-5. MSU's last victory over the Wolverines came in 1978, a 24-15 decision in Ann Arbor.

TEAM RECORDS-- MSU stands at 2-2-1 while Michigan raises its record to 4-1.

ATTENDANCE-- 78,033. Today's game marks the 36th consecutive sellout between the two schools.

HIGHLIGHTS-- Michigan State freshman Pat Shurmur (Dearborn Heights) made his first career start for the Spartans today at right guard. Shurmur was an all-state selection his senior year at Dearborn Divine Child.

Michigan Head Coach Bo Schembechler becomes only the third coach in the history of the Big Ten to capture 100 conference victories. Woody Hayes (Ohio State) and Amos Alonzo Stagg (University of Chicago) were the other two coaches.

For the fifth time this season Michigan led in time of Possession. In today's game, the Wolverines had control of the ball for 38 minutes and 2 seconds, while MSU had the ball for 21 minutes and 18 seconds.

The last time Michigan State was shutout was Nov. 22, 1980 against Iowa. The Hawks prevailed in that game by a 41-0 margin.

The last time Michigan State was shutout by Michigan was in 1973 when the Wolverines blanked MSU 31-0 in East Lansing.

Michigan State's defense has not given up a touchdown in the third quarter this season.

Today's 42-0 win over Michigan State is Michigan's biggest point differential over the Spartans since 1947 when U-M won 55-0.

Michigan quarterback Steve Smith established himself as Michigan's all-time pass completion leader passing Rick Leach. Smith has completed 258 passes in 517 attempts. Leach completed 250 during his career.

Michigan's 67 rushing attempts ties the Big Ten single game best for 1983. U-M rushed 67 times earlier this season (Sept. 24) against Wisconsin.

Michigan State tight end Butch Rolle's five receptions today are a career best for him. His 51 yards in receptions are also a personal high.

Michigan senior tight end Milt Carthens made his first receptions of the 1983 season. Carthens snared two passes for 49 yards and one touchdown.

Michigan State punter Ralf Mojsiejenko had a busy day, punting nine times for a 45.6-yard average. Mojsiejenko went into today's contest with a 43.4 yard average.

Michigan's defense went into today's game giving up an average of 303.5 yards a game. Today the Wolverine's defense gave up just 111 total yards to the Spartans.
