*** GAME NOTES ***

SERIES -- Michigan now leads the all-time series by a 55-24-5 margin. In games played at Spartan Stadium, the Wolverines hold a 16-6-2 advantage and have won 10 of the last 11 meetings played at East Lansing.

ATTENDANCE -- Today's crowd of 80,157 is the third-largest crowd ever to see a game at Spartan Stadium (80,401 vs. Notre Dame last year is the all-time mark). It is the largest attendance figure for a Michigan State-Michigan contest bettering the previous crowd of 80,093 in 1971.

CAPTAINS -- For Michigan State, Coutrney Hawkins, Brian Vooletich, Jim Johnson and Alan Haller. For Michigan, Erick Anderson and Greg Skrepenak.

NOTES -- The 73 points generated by the Spartans and Wolverines is the highest point total in the modern era (post World War II).

The 45 points scored by the Wolverines is their highest point total against an MSU team since 1947 when the Maize and Blue recorded a 55-0 win.

MSU's Courtney Hawkins' two TD receptions this afternoon were his 10th and 11th of his career and moved him into ninth place on the MSU all-time list.

Michigan's Jesse Johnson's 29-yard TD run in the third quarter was the longest ruhsing TD against the Spartans this year, bettering Billy Smith's (Central Michigan) and Trent Green (Indiana) 15-yard scampers.

Michigan's Elvis Grbac's three TD passes marks the fourth time in five games this with three or more scoring passes. He now has 43 career TD passes moving ahead of Steve Smith (42, 1980-83) into second place on Michigan's career TD throwing list. Rick Leach (1975-78) holds the record with 48.

Michigan's Desmond Howard's two touchdown receptions gives him 12 TDs on the season (10 via reception) and has at least two TDs in every game this year. Howard has at least one TD in eight consecutive games and 10 in the last 11 of M contests. Howard's eight catches for 101 yards marks the fifth 100-yard reception dau in his career, the first in 1991. Howard reached the 100-career reception mark this afternoon and currentl ranks fifth on Michigan's career list with 102.

Michigan's J.D. Carlson booted 6 of 6 extra points oday stretching his consecutive streak to 94. His nine total points today enabled him to move into a tie for fifth place in career scoring with Rick Leach with 204 (Michigan's all-time list).

Michigan's Ricky Powers reached the 100-yard rushing mark (148 yds.) today, the eighth time in his career that he has accomplished that feat (the seventh time in his last nine games). Michigan is 8-0 when Powers rushes for 100 or more yards.

Michigan State's Jim Miller enjoyed a big day for the Spartans, connecting on 30 of 39 pass attempts for 302 yards. It was the first time that an MSU quarterback had passed for 300 or more yards since Nov. 15, 1986 when Dave Yarema threw for 352 yards in a 24-21 loss to Northwestern. Miller's 30 completions ties him with Dave Yarema for second place on the MSU single-game list for completions while his 39 attempts ties him with Ed Smith (vs. list for completions while his 39 attempts ties him with Ed Smith (vs. Wyoming in '76) for eighth place on the MSU single-game ladder. Miller's 302 yards is the ninth-highest total turned in by a Spartan player for one game.

MSU's Courtney Hawkins' eight pass receptions gives him 115 during his career and enables him to move into third place on the MSU all-time list. Hawkins entered today's game with 108 receptions and moved ahead of Kirk Gibson (112, 1975-78) and Eugene Byrd (114, 1975-79). Hawkins now has 1,965 reception yards and stands fourth on the MSU all-time list.

Michigan State totaled season highs in points (28), first downs (25), passing yards (323) and totaled yards (407).

You can see there's a future for Jim Miller. He does some things pretty good. He had protection a lot of the time. When he didn't have protection, that's when we had problems withsacks. Well, emotions go up and down during the game and I'm sure that it hurt for a while but they come out of that. That doesn't last very long. That certainly wasn't a turning point. That was just a flaw. We came back aft3r that and went out at halftime with 21-7.

We thought we had a chance to come back in the second half. Probably the thing that hurt was the first (Michigan) drive when they took it after halftime and drove the ball some 70 yards and scored. Basically one pass and all running. Our run defense was poor today and part of the reason it was poor was because of their blocking and because of the way they broke tackles. Some of the great runs they had were the result of the runners breaking the tackles.
