Michigan vs. Houston POST-GAME NOTES

Wolverines Tie Scoring Records

Michigan's 35 second quarter points in today's game tie the Michigan modern day record for scoring in a quarter. The Wolverines' second quarter outburst equalled the previous Michigan record for scoring in a quarter set in the second quarter of Michigan's 49-14 victory at Northwestern in 1982. The 35 second quarter points are the most scored in a quarter by any team in Michigan Stadium in the modern era. The 61 points scored by the Wolverines tie for the most points ever allowed by a Houston team. Previously the Cougars yielded 61 points to Texas Tech in 1954. The 61 points are the most scored by a Michigan team since the Wolverines' 62-14 win at Wisconsin in 1988. The Wolverines' 54-point win is Michigan's largest margin of victory since the Wolverines defeated Illinois by 56 points (69-13) in Ann Arbor in 1986. The largest Michigan margins of victory in modern history were 130 points (130-0) against West Virginia in 1904, 85 points (85-0) at Chicago in 1939, 69 points (69-0) against Pittsburgh in 1947, 69 points (69-0) against Northwestern in 1975, and 57 points (57-0) at Illinois in 1969.

Wheatley's Wonders

Tyrone Wheatley started the Michigan scoring today with a 99-yard return of the opening kickoff for a touchdown. **Wheatley's** kickoff return tied **Dennis Fitzgerald's** 99-yard kickoff return (also for a touchdown) in Michigan's 24-17 loss at Michigan State in 1960 for the longest kickoff return in Michigan history. The last time a Wolverine returned a kickoff for a touchdown was **Desmond Howard's** 93-yard TD return in Michigan's 35-13 win at Boston College in 1991. In addition to his kickoff return heroics, **Wheatley** added 45 yards on seven carries, including a seven-yard touchdown run, giving him 144 all-purpose yards today. For the season, **Wheatley** has gained 72 yards on 13 carries and one touchdown, has caught one pass for 27 yards and one touchdown, and has returned three kickoffs for 140 yards and one touchdown.

Collins Ties TD Passing Record

Todd Collins, making his second consecutive start in relief of injured starter **Elvis Grbac**, tied the Michigan single game touchdown passing record with four TD passes. **Collins'** four TD strikes (on passes of 43, 23, 18, and 12 yards) tie the record established by **Grbac** (against Florida State in 1991 and Mississippi in the 1991 Gator Bowl), **Michael Taylor** (at Minnesota in 1989), **Chris Zurbrugg** (at Purdue in 1984), and **Steve Smith** (against Purdue in 1983). Additionally the five TD passes thrown by Wolverine quarterbacks today tie the Michigan team record for TD passes in a game set previously in Michigan's 49-15 win at Minnesota in 1989 and in the Wolverines' 49-7 win against Cornell in 1952. **Collins** completed 17 of 24 passes for 205 yards, one interception, and four touchdowns against the Cougars, moving his season totals to 46 of 66 for 490 yards, two interceptions and six touchdowns. In his career **Collins** now has completed 62 of 92 passes for 628 yards, two interceptions and six touchdowns.

McGee's Moments

Tight end **Tony McGee** continued his strong season, catching two passes for 45 yards and two touchdowns (the first TD receptions of his career) against the Cougars. **McGee's** two touchdowns (on receptions of 23 and 18 yards) made him the first Michigan tight end to catch two touchdown passes in a game since **Eric Kattus** caught two TD passes in Michigan's 31-0 win at Michigan State in 1985. **Ron Kramer** holds the Michigan record for TD receptions by a tight end with a three-TD performance in Michigan's 42-7 win over Missouri in 1955. **McGee** now has 11 receptions for 112 yards and two touchdowns this season and has 15 receptions for 160 yards and two touchdowns in his career. **McGee's** receiving totals in this season's first three games are comparable to Michigan's aggregate tight end receiving totals from the whole 1991 season when Michigan tight ends combined for 11 receptions for 99 yards and two touchdowns (**Diebolt**-eight receptions, 60 yards, two TDs; **McGee**-three receptions for 39 yards).

Firsts

Mercury Hayes had the first touchdown reception of his career, a 43-yard grab. **Hayes** finished the day with two receptions for 53 yards and one TD, moving his season totals to four receptions for 76 yards and one touchdown... **Amani Toomer** had the first touchdown reception of his career on a 14-yard pass from **Jay Riemersma**, the first TD pass of **Riemersma's** career. **Toomer** caught two passes for 22 yards and one TD on the day, moving his season totals to four catches for 37 yards and one touchdown... **Pat Maloney** made his first start of the season against the Cougars... Quarterback **Jason Carr** saw his first game action as a Wolverine and completed the first pass of his Michigan career... **Eric Lovell** kicked the first PAT of his Michigan career... **Ed Davis**, appearing in his second game as a Wolverine, had the first 100+ yard rushing game of his career, gaining 105 yards on 11 carries, including an 11-yard TD run, the second TD run of his career.

CORRECTION-Page seven of the stats book has a typo. In the scoring summary, **Ed Davis' TD run should be 11 yards, instead of 26.** The play-by-play has the correct yardage and **Davis' statistics are accurate.**

COACHES POST-GAME QUOTES

Houston Head Coach John Jenkins

On Michigan's Offensive Line:

"Anytime I saw their offense, there was excellent pass protection. At times, it looked like a seven-on-seven drill, where there's no rush. They had big, huge, massive specimens up front, who did wonderful job."

On Michigan's Depth:

"There's very little drop-off between the second and third teams."

On Opening Kickoff Return for TD:

"They went downtown on the opening kickoff and it was downhill for us from that point on."

On Michigan's Defense:

"The relentless pass rush was key. They really didn't blitz much, although they did bring some linebackers from outside the tackles. They used very disciplined zone coverage with a little man-to-man. I think that without a doubt the players in their secondary can run."

On Todd Collins:

"Very impressive. He's a big, tall guy with the ability to see down field and read defenses well."

On Michigan as a team:

"Michigan is a great team, a great program; I tip my hat to them. There's a lot they can do from here, with the momentum they got out of today. It will be interesting to see how far this Michigan team can go. They've got a chance to go all the way and possibly be undefeated."

On Michigan's fourth and-two touchdown

"Damned if you do, damned if you don't. That's football. It's our job to stop them."

Houston Quarterback Jimmy Klingler

On Michigan's Defense

"They did a great job of disguising their coverages and they rotated them throughout. They didn't do anything we hadn't seen on film or anything out of the ordinary."

Houston Quarterback Donald Douglas

On Michigan's Victory:

"They were a better team today. I give them credit. We've got to put this behind us and get ready for the SWC. The kickoff return shocked us and put us in a hole early."

Houston Linebacker Ryan McCoy

On Michigan's Offense:

"They executed extremely well, especially when we missed tackles. They caught and passed very well. We were not concerned with their size and speed; it didn't surprise me. I expected our performance to be better."

Michigan Head Coach Gary Moeller

On Michigan's Victory

"I don't know how the whole thing unfolded. We anticipated rain in the second half, so we wanted the ball when it was dry, to give it to them in the second half, when it was wet. And it helps when Wheatley runs the ball 99 yards with the kickoff."

On Defense's Performance:

"I was really pleased with the way they played. The defensive coaches, led by Lloyd Carr, did a great job devising the defense, and the kids executed it."

On the Keys to the Defense:

"We mixed it up well. We had pressure early, with Alfie (Burch) and (Shonte) Peoples coming off the corner. The defensive line played well, playing a few plays and then changing. We played against the run extremely well."

On the Upcoming Schedule:

"The next three weeks are crucial. We have to be ready. The last time we lost a league game, was back-to-back to Michigan State and Iowa right here."

On Running Up A Score:

"You know it's not my intention; we're just giving kids a chance. You can't hold up players when they get their chance to play. Jay (Riemersma) and Eddie (Davis) scored on the run. We had everyone in the game who could play."
