Purdue is 3-5 overall and 2-3 in the Big Ten. The Boilermakers will play at Illinois next week.
Michigan, which is ranked third nationally, is $7-0-1$ overall and $5-0$ in the league. The Wolverines will play at Northwestern next Saturday.

Series Record:
This was Michigan's sixth straight series victory to give it a 32-10 lead in the rivalry.

Statistical Notes:
Michigan set a Big Ten record today with its 18th consecutive league victory. The Wolverines had been tied with Ohio State (1954-56, 1967-69 and 1974-76) for the old mark of 17 straight conference victories.
Michigan has won 16 straight league games on the road, and it is $19-0-1$ in its last 20 Big Ten road games.
Michigan's Pat Maloney intercepted his fourth career pass.today.
Purdue's Joe O'Leary extended his string of successful field goal attempts to 12 with a first-half field goal, but then missed later to end the streak. He still has not missed a PAT kick this year in 18 attempts.
Purdue's Scott Green caught his first collegiate touchdown pass today.
Michigan's Tony McGee, from Terre Haute, Ind., had a career-high 54 yards in pass receptions, including his fourth TD this season.
Michigan's Jesse Johnson rushed for 118 yards today, his first effort over the century mark this year. It was his third career 100 -yard effort, all on the road and all in the league. It was his second-highest rushing total (best was 168 at Iowa in 1991).
Purdue's Mike Alstott rushed for 101 yards today (98 in the first half), his first career effort over 100 yards.
Purdue forced Michigan's Chris Stapleton to punt a career-high six times today. (ties career-high: six vs. Michigan St. in 1989).
The final play of the first half (a 49 -yard pass from Purdue's Eric Hunter to Jermaine Ross) was the Boilers' longest play of the season.
Michigan's Elvis Grbac threw two TD passes today, adding to his school career record. He now has 65 TD passes.
Michigan's Walter Smith had his second 40-plus yard scoring play in the last two weeks. His 43 -yard TD reception today was his first TD reception of the season. Last week, he ran 46 yards on a reverse for a TD against Minnesota.
There was only one turnover today, an interception on Purdue's final offensive play.
Michigan controlled the ball for $10: 28$ in the third quarter (scored two TD's and one field goal), yet Purdue had the most time of possession for the game (30:31-29:29).
Michigan had held opponents to $0-25$ on third down conversions (Indiana and Minnesota) the last two weeks. Purdue was 6-14 on third downs today.
Purdue's 17-7 halftime lead was the first time since 1989 Michigan trailed by as many as 10 points at halftime (14-3 vs. USC in 1989 Rose Bowl). It was the first time Michigan trailed by 10 at halftime in a Big Ten game since 1987 (14-3 at Michigan St.).
