"I mahe some plays, but I feel I still have a lot of things I can do better. I need to improve on special teams specifically. I misjudged a few kicks today."

JARRETT IRONS

"We did some good things defensively, but we need to improve in a lot of ways. We need to look at the things we messed up doing and do better. You can't focus on bad things. We just have to go back to basics and work hard."

POST-GAME HOUSTON QUOTES

Head Coach Kim Helton

"The bottom line is we just didn't execute well. You drive the ball down to the nine-yard line, get a bad snap, and you lose those three points. Then you drive down to the two-yard line, drop the snap on the first down, then run an off-tackle play, lose eight and then fumble."

On the opening kick-off:

"It was certainly an unpleasant experience having that ball called down on the one-yard line. I saw that same kick-off at Southern California called in the endzone a couple weeks ago."

"I think the one positive thing that came out of the game is that our players went through a lot of adversity and held their head up, and played a clean, hard-nosed, cut football game like grown tough men play it. There wasn't a lot of whining and no yelling at the referees, even though I thought the referees were a little questionable for both teams."

On freshman quarterback Chuck Clemens:

"I think Chuck is our second-team quarterback, he does a good job. We're very blessed to have two good ones (quarterbacks). I thought that he played under a situation with a growing new offense, and is just trying to learn it. He made some good plays. The young guy did a great job, in all fairness to him."

On their progression to a more traditional offense:

"We'd like to be a two-back three-wideout offense, or a one-back, one-tight end, three-wideout offense. We'd like to be like Michigan when you get close to the goal line, and be able to put in two tight ends, and run off-tackle with a big running back and score. I hope to be a complete two-back football team by the time we meet Baylor (Oct. 2), but we only have one running back right now and Lamar (Smith) did well, so maybe not."

On their defense:

"I was not impressed with our defense at all. Whether it was in the first quarter, second quarter, or any other point in the game."

Running Back Lamar Smith

"In the first two games (of the season) I couldn't read my keys because I wasn't used to the offense, but now we had that two week layoff and I got some quickness, and the offensive line played great today."

On being able to run against Michigan:

"I wasn't surprised because Michigan is human. They're a good football team but they're human. I was not surprised, we executed well, we had some bad officiating but that's life."

Michigan's team compared to last year's:

"Michigan's football team is the same as last year's, it's just that our offensive team is different this year; we ran the ball more."

"We were fired up coming into the game, we refused to get blown out. We told ourselves we were not going to be blown. We were going to come out here and stick it to Michigan. We tried and like I said, we not only had to play Michigan, we had to play Big Ten officials."

POST-GAME NOTES

TOUCHDOWN MAN

Tyrone Wheatley rushed for three touchdowns today (on runs of 25, five, and nine yards), marking the third time in his career that **Wheatley** has rushed for three touchdowns in a single game. Last season, **Wheatley** rushed for three TDs against Iowa and Washington. **Wheatley** now has 28 career rushing touchdowns, tied for sixth place on Michigan's career rushing touchdown list with **Gordon Bell** (1973-75). **Wheatley's** three-touchdown performance moved him into a fifth place tie with **Bill Taylor** (1969-71) in career total touchdowns with 32 (28 rushing, three receiving, and one kickoff return). **Wheatley's** 32 career total touchdowns give him 192 career points, ninth most in Michigan history. **Wheatley** has now scored two or more touchdowns in each game this season (two rushing against Notre Dame and one rushing and one on a kickoff return against Washington State), and has scored at least one TD in 11 of his last 13 games.

WHEATLEY RUNS WILD

For the third time in three games this season, **Tyrone Wheatley** rushed for over 100 yards. **Wheatley** carried the ball 26 times for 171 yards (6.6 avg) and three touchdowns against the Cougars. **Wheatley's** 171 rushing yards are his highest total this season, and give him 434 yards on 66 carries (6.6 yards per carry, 144.7 rushing yards per game) and six rushing TDs this season. **Wheatley** now has 2339 career rushing yards (10th most in school history) on 337 carries (6.94 avg.-best in school history) and 28 rushing TDs. **Wheatley** has now rushed for 100+ yards 11 times in his career (the sixth most 100+ yard rushing games by a Wolverine), five times in the last five games, and 10 times in his last 12 games. Michigan is 9-1-1 in games in which **Wheatley** rushes for 100 or more yards and is 9-1 in games in which he rushes for over 100 yards, with the only loss coming two weeks ago against Notre Dame. **Wheatley** has now rushed for 150+ yards four times in his career (171 yards today, 235 vs. Washington in the 1993 Rose Bowl, 172 against MSU in 1992, and 224 against Iowa in 1992), making him the ninth player in Michigan history to accomplish that feat. Michigan is 4-0 when **Wheatley** rushes for 150+ yards.

COLLINS' COMPLETIONS

Todd Collins completed 20 of 34 passes today, moving him into first place on Michigan's career completion percentage list. In his career, **Collins** has completed 63.0% of his passes (143 of 227), surpassing the career completion marks of **Elvis Grbac** (62.5%) and **Jim Harbaugh** (62.4%). **Collins** also threw for 267 yards today (the seventh-highest single game passing total in school history), marking the fifth time in his five career starts that **Collins** has thrown for over 200 yards. **Collins'** 267 passing yards are his highest total of the season, and the second highest of his career. **Collins** now has four of Michigan's top 12 single game passing yardage totals—ranking fourth (285 vs. Oklahoma State in 1992), seventh (267 today), eighth (265 vs. Washington State), and 12th (251 against Notre Dame). **Collins** now ranks 15th in career passing yards (1614 yards), 11th in completions (143) and sixth in career passing efficiency rating (134.9 rating points).

MERCURY RISES AGAIN

Mercury Hayes caught 6 passes for 127 (21.2) yards today, the highest single game receiving yardage total of his career. **Hayes**, Michigan's leading receiver this season, now has 30 receptions for 464 yards (15.5 avg.) and five touchdowns this season. **Hayes** also had a splendid all-purpose performance against the Cougars, amassing 220 all-purpose yards (127 receiving, one rushing, 38 on punt returns, and 54 on kickoff returns). For the season, **Hayes** now has 735 all-purpose yards (464 receiving, six rushing, 321 kickoff returns, 144 punt returns).

TOOMER CATCHES ON

Amani Toomer also had a great receiving day, catching five passes for 94 yards (18.8 avg.), and one touchdown. **Toomer's** 94 receiving yards are his highest this season and the second-highest single game receiving total of his career (his previous best was a 112-yard performance last season vs. Northwestern). For the season, **Toomer** now has 14 receptions for 221 yards (15.8 avg.) and two touchdowns.

FIRSTS

Ty Law had several personal firsts in today's game. He had his first punt return (four yards), first interception (25-yard return), and first fumble (on the interception return) of his career today...**Tshimanga (Tim) Biakabutuka** had his first carry and scored his first touchdown of his career today...**Jean-Agnus Charles** had his first career tackle for loss (good for a 14-yard loss)...**Charles Winters** had his first career kickoff return (10 yards)...**Mike Vanderbeek** made his first career tackles.
