## Purduae Head Coach Jizn Colletto

"It was a great college game, very competitive. I was afraid coming in that we would get run out of here, but we played very hard and the defense played their hearts out."

On the Purdue defense:
"We hustled around against a very physical team and played very well. Teams that are good, like Michigan, do what the defense gives them, that's why they threw to the tight end because that's what we were giving them."

On the Purdue offense:
"Offensively, we've had problems because we're very young. I thought we were going to take the lead on the drive with (Mike) Alstott's run, but the clipping penalty killed us. That's beeen with us all year, we get close and then something bad happens."

On his quarterback situation:
"We went with Matt (Pike) to start the second half because (Rick) Trefzger wasn't as calm as he has been. He (Trezfger) took some hits and he had a case of the flu, so we thought we'd try Pike, but Pike then hurt his shoulder and we had to go back to Rick (Trefzger)."

On the 12 -man penalty with 2 minutes to go:
"There is a lot of discussion in the league about their (Michigan) substitution patterns up here. But once the ball is in play you have to be ready and we weren't, that's my fault."

## Michigani Head Coach Grary Moeller

On the win in general:
"It was a very pleasing victory. We were able to get a lot of newcomers in the game and they played well ... it's one of the big victories I've had since I've been here. The players worked very hard and they didn't quit. They kept focused and that's what it's all about ... We came back as a team. It gives us something we can build on."

On freshmen in the backfield:
"We were able to get two true freshman in the backfield (Tim Biakabutuka at tailback and Jon Ritchie at fullback) for two quarters, and they gained valuable experience ... Tim (Biakabutuka) did some goofy things a couple of times, but once he got his feet on the ground he did a good job."

On the key to the victory:
"The defense was better up the middle ... you have to be good up the middle as in all sports, and putting Stanley at middle guard provided senior leadership. He excepted the move."

## Freshman Tailback Tum Biakabutuka

"My dream was to play at Michigan ... I was anxious to play ... I helped the team and that's my major goal. Tyrone (Wheatley) and Ricky (Powers) gave me advice after every run, we all cheer each other on."

## Buster Stanley

"The young guys really stepped up today, they played a big role in the game. We're just looking to win the next two games, and we're just looking to the future."

On lineup/position changes:
"Coach Carr said this week in practice that whether you're a three-year starter or freshman, the toughest 11 players would play. If you don't practice hard, you don't play."

IRONS SETS 'RI' RECORD
Freshman inside linebacker Jarrett trons established a new Michigan record for tackles by a player in his freshman season. Iroms collected 12 tackles against the Boilermakers (nine solo and three assists) to lift his season total to 87 tackles ( 54 solo and 33 assists), breaking former Wolverine inside linebacker and 1991 Butkus Award winner Erick Anderson's record for tackles by a first year player of 77 set in 1988. Irons' 12 tackles were the most of any Wolverine against Purdue, marking the fourth straight game and the fifth time in six games that Iroms has led the Wolverines in tackles. In that six game span, Irons has made 77 tackles ( 14 against lowa, nine at Michigan State, 14 at Penn State, 11 against Illinois, 16 at Wisconsin, and 12 today). Hrows leads Michigan with 87 tackles this season and is attempting to become the only Wolverine besides Anderson (whose 77 tackles tied for the team lead in 1988) to lead the team in tackles as a freshman. Trons also made his first interception of his career against Purdue and returned it 27 yards, the longest interception return by a Wolverine this season.

## FIRSTS

Freshman tight end Damon Jones made his first career start against Purdue and also caught the first pass of his career. Jones' first career reception was a nine-yard reception and he added a seven-yard catch against the Boilermakers...Freshman defensive lineman Damon Densom made his first career start and collected three solo tackles...Sophomore tailback Ed Davis had the first start of his career today. Davis carried the ball a career-high 19 times for 73 yards ( 3 rd most in his career)...Fullback Jon Ritchie scored his first touchdown as a Wolverine on a one-yard run. Ritchie rushed nine times for 36 yards, both career highs, and had a career-long 11-yard rush.

## TOUCHDOWN TM

Freshman tailback Tshimangm (Tim) Biakabatukar had the best day of career against Purdue. Biaksabatuka rushed 24 times for 140 yards ( 5.8 avg .) and two touchdowns. Biakabatuka's touchdowns came on runs of 25 and three yards. Bakabatuka's 140 rushing yards are the fourth most in a game by a Wolverine this season, trailing Tyrone Wheatley's 192 yards at Penn State, 171 yards against Houston, and 146 against Notre Dame. Biakabatuka's two rushing touchdowns mark the first time since Ricky Powers rushed for two TDs against Oklahoma State in 1992 that a Wolverine other than Wheatley has scored two rushing TDs in a game. For the season, Biakabatuka has 31 carries for 145 yards ( 4.7 avg .) and three touchdowns.

## RUSHING FOR SIX

Biakabataka's 25 -yard touchdown run, which came with $4: 33$ left in the third quarter, was Michigan's first rushing touchdown since Tyrone Whentley's three-yard touchdown run against lowa with 9:08 left in the third quarter, ending a span of 304 minutes and 35 seconds of play in which Michigan had failed to rush for a touchdown. Michigan scored all three of its touchdowns on the ground, marking the first time since Michigan's 13-13 tie with Ohio State that the Wolverines have not had a passing touchdown. Michigan ran the ball 57 times for 278 yards ( 4.8 avg .) and three touchdowns today. The team's 278 rushing yards are the most since the Wolverines rolled up 308 rushing yards in the $38-311993$ Rose Bowl win over Washington and the 57 rushing attempts are the most since the Wolverines ran 66 times in their 63-13 win over Minnesota in 1992.

## COLLINS PASSES 2,000

With his 177 passing yards against Purdue, Todd Collins became only the third player in Michigan history to pass for over 2,000 yards in a season. Collins has 2,106 passing yards this season, joining Jimi klarbaugh ( 2,729 passing yards in 1986) and Elvis Grbac (2,085 passing yards in 1991) as the only Wolverines to pass for 2,000 yards in a season. Callins completed 18 of 21 passes for a 857 completion rate, the fourth highest single game mark for all games and the second-highest single game completion percentage by a Michigan quarterback with at least 20 passing attempts. Collins now has completed $64.6 \%$ of his passes in his career ( 239 completions on 370 attempts), the best career completion percentage in school history. Collims now has 2,844 career passing yards, 156 passing yards shy of joining Grbac ( 6,460 yards in 1989-92), Harbaugh ( 5,449 in 1983-86), Steve Smith ( 4,860 yards in 1975-78) as the only players in Michigan history to pass for 3,000 yards in a career.

## 500th HOME WHN

Today's 25-10 win over Purdue was the 500th home win in Michigan football history. The Wolverines are 500-115-21 (.803 winning percentage) in home games.

## BURKHOLDER'S BEST

Senior tight end Mare Burkholder had the best game of his career against Purdue, catching seven passes for 48 yards, both career highs. Burkholder's petformance surpassed his previous career bests of two receptions for 40 yards set last week against Wisconsin. Burkholder has 12 receptions for 114 this season and 14 receptions for 120 yards in his career.
