MICHIGAN vs. COLORADO Post-Game Notes

WOLVERINES LOSE IN LAST-SECOND HEARTBREAKER

A 258 yard passing performance by **Todd Collins** and the return of **Tyrone Wheatley** was spoiled by a last-second 64-yard pass from **Kordell Stewart** to **Michael Westbrook**, giving the visiting Buffaloes a stunning 27-26 victory. The Buffaloes had 511 yards of total offense, the second most for an opponent in Michigan history; Colorado and season-opening opponent Boston College are two of only three teams in 'M' history to have 500 or more yards in a single game against the Wolverines.

THE RETURN OF MISTER SIX

All-America, Heisman Trophy and Doak Walker Award candidate **Tyrone Wheatley** saw his first game action of the season against the Buffaloes, carrying the ball 17 times for 50 yards and one touchdown. With his one touchdown against Colorado, **Wheatley** broke the Michigan modern record for career total touchdowns. **Wheatley** now has 41 touchdowns, breaking the former record held by **Anthony Carter** (40 in 1979-82). **Wheatley** improved upon his 'M' record for career rushing touchdowns with 36, breaking the record formerly held by **Rick Leach** (34 in 1975-78). In addition, **Wheatley's** touchdown against the Buffaloes gives him 246 points, passing **Carter** (244 points in 1979-82) for third on the 'M' career points list.

Wheatley's 50 yards against the Buffaloes give him 3,084 career rushing yards, moving him past **Bill Taylor** (3,072 in 1969-71) for fourth on the Michigan career rushing yardage list. With his 17 attempts against Colorado, **Tyrone Wheatley** moved up to 11th place on the all-time 'M' career attempts list, passing **Leach** (487 attempts in 1975-78) and **Ron Johnson** (487 attempts in 1966-68).

COLLINS' COMPLETIONS

In completing 17 of 24 passes (.708 completion percentage) for 258 yards and one touchdown against Colorado, Johnny Unitas Award candidate **Todd Collins** increased his career completion percentage to .652 (326 completions in 500 attempts), the highest career completion percentage in Michigan history. In 1993, **Collins** completed 63.9 percent of his passes (tied for fifth on Michigan's single season completion list) after setting the school record with a 64.9 completion rate in 1992 as a backup to former 'M' quarterback **Elvis Grbac**.

COLLINS' YARDAGE

With his 258 yards against Colorado, **Collins** now has thrown for 250 or more yards in seven of his 17 career starts, the most in Michigan history. **Collins** now has thrown for 200 or more yards in 11 games, just one game shy of **Jim Harbaugh** (12 in 1983-86) for first place on the 'M' all-time list. **Collins'** 258 yards against the Buffaloes give him 4,080 career passing yards, the fifth most in 'M' history. **Collins** trails **Rick Leach** (4,284 in 1975-78), **Steve Smith** (4,860 in 1980-83), **Jim Harbaugh** (5,449 in 1983-86) and **Elvis Grbac** (6,460 in 1989-92).

BIG PLAY DUO

Signal-caller **Todd Collins** has been a part of many "big plays" at Michigan, including 14 touchdown passes of 20 or more yards. **Collins** has connected to junior wide receiver **Amani Toomer** on six of his 14 touchdown strikes of 20 or more yards. Against Colorado, **Collins** found **Toomer** for a 65-yard touchdown bomb. **Collins** and **Toomer** also connected on touchdown passes of 38 and 46 yards against Boston College in Michigan's 1994 season opener. Last season, **Collins** hit **Toomer** on a 31-yard touchdown pass against North Carolina State in the 1994 Hall of Fame Bowl, and also reached **Toomer** for a 56-yard touchdown pass against Illinois and a 24-yard touchdown pass versus Washington State.

THOMPSON RULES TURNOVERS

For the fifth time in six games, defensive back **Clarence Thompson** has been a part of a Michigan defensive turnover. Against the Buffaloes, **Thompson** recovered a career-high two fumbles as well as breaking up two Colorado passes. Against Notre Dame, **Thompson** stripped Irish tailback Lee Becton (who had not fumbled in two seasons) of the ball and recovered the fumble on Notre Dames 18-yard line. In the season-opener against Boston College, **Thompson** picked off a pass from Eagles quarterback Mark Hartsell. Last season, **Thompson** intercepted a pass by North Carolina State's Terry Harvey and returned it 43 yards for a touchdown in a 42-7 victory over the Wolfpack in the 1993 Hall of Fame Bowl. **Thompson** also had an interception against Minnesota in the second to the last game of the 1993 season.

Inside linebacker **Jarrett Irons** tied his personal best with 16 tackles against the Buffaloes...**Kerwin Waldroup** had a personal best eight tackles against Colorado, including two tackles for a total loss of 14 yards...**Earnest Sanders** had his first career fumble recovery...**Chuck Winters** had an interception against the Buffaloes, the second of his career...**Trent Zenkewicz** had two tackles for
