MSU Head Coach George Peries

In General:

"We got beat fair and square. They (Michigan) played an inspired football game today, one of their better ones.

On What the Loss Means to Michigan State:

"Well the good news is it's not a one loss conference and I don't know if one loss will win this conference. We have got a big game coming up next week against Ohio State."

"Losses are like funerals, wins are like weddings."

On the play of Michigan overall:

"They are a good team, and they brought it to us. They put yards and points on the board and won the game."

"Give Michigan credit, they played well, they played great in the first and second half. They ran well and threw the ball well, that's why they won."

On Michigan State's inability to run the ball:

"It is a concern when you run well last week and don't this week. But, we're playing two different teams, so give credit to Michigan."

"They (Michigan) knew we wanted to run the football and made sure we couldn't."

On Where MSU goes from here:

"Now we have to get ready for our next conference game against Ohio State."

Michigan Head Coach Gary Moeller

On The Game in General:

"I'm very, very happy, very pleased, and very proud, but we have a very big game next week...we are on a long mission and we have some great football teams to play. We have to stay focused on what we have ahead.

"We wanted to get points early, and it's the same old same old, it gets down to turnovers and rushing the football."

" We had a good game offensively, but we have to do it back to back."

On The Offensive Line Playing Better:

"I'll take some heat off of them. The biggest thing since the second half of the lowa game is that the running backs are playing better..."
"The Offensive linemen, don't like to hear about Michigan State's line all of the

time, but we know we have to keep improving."

On The Play Of Our Defense:

"Our focus was to stop the run and I was surprised at the pressure the defense supplied early. We put pressure on Banks and my guess is, without having looked at tape, is that the coverage was probably pretty good."

On Blanking Mill Coleman:

It was important, he's another weapon they have, he's a fine football player."

On Regaining Bragging Rights:

"It's very important. The key is getting back the old wooden trophy with Paul Bunyan on top. It isn't very pretty, but it is to the coaches, the players and especially the head coach. We will welcome it (the trophy) back to Schembechler Hall."

On The Play Of Tyrone Wheatley

"It meant a lot. He's a fine back, sometimes he's got to get lathered up to get going."

POST-GAME NOTES MICHIGAN VS. MICHIGAN STATE

Fueled by a three touchdown (one passing, two rushing), 153-yard rushing performance by tailback Tyrone Wheatley, a one touchdown, 141-yard rushing performance by Tshimanga Biakabutuka and a 211yard passing performance (16 completions of 23 attempts) for no interceptions and one touchdown by quarterback Todd Collins, Michigan defeated intra-state rival Michigan State, 40-20.

100-YARD RUSHING DUO

With Tyrone Wheatley's 153 rushing yards on 23 attempts (6.7 yards per carry) and Tshimanga Biakabutuka's 141 rushing yards on 15 attempts (9.4 yards per carry), this backfield duo became the first Wolverines to run for 100 or more yards in the same game since Ricky Powers (151 rushing yards on 26 carries) and Jesse Johnson (104 rushing yards on 21 carries) ran for a combined 255 rushing yards against Illinois in 1991. The Wolverines racked up a total of 349 rushing yards, marking the first time that Michigan has run for over 300 yards since the Wolverines had 308 yards (including a 15 carry, 235-yard performance by Tyrone Wheatley) in a 38-31 victory over Washington in the 1993 Rose Bowl.

THE RETURN OF MISTER SIX

With one passing touchdown and two rushing touchdowns against the Spartans, Heisman Trophy and Doak Walker Award candidate Tyrone Wheatley increased his career modern Michigan record for touchdowns to 46. Wheatley also improved upon his 'M' career rushing touchdown mark, upping his total to 39, five better than the record formerly held by Rick Leach (34 in 1979-82). Wheatley's touchdown reception (from Collins for five yards) was his first receiving touchdown since he scored on a 48-yard pass from Collins in last year's lowa

Wheatley's three touchdowns against Michigan State ties his single-game personal best and gives him 276 career points, the second best on the Michigan career points list and tops among non-kickers. Wheatley

needs 31 more points to pass Mike Gillette (307 in 1985-88) for first on the all-time list.

WHEATLEY RUSHING YARDS EQUAL WOLVERINE WINS

With his 153 rushing yard performance against the Spartans, Wheatley has now gained over 150 yards in both of his starts (his other was a 182-yard rushing performance against Iowa) of the 1994 season. Wheatley has 17 career games of 100 or more rushing yards, including seven games of over 100 rushing yards last season. Michigan is 15-1-1 when Wheatley rushes for 100 or more yards in his career. Michigan is 2-0 this season when Wheatley has rushed for over 100 yards and 0-1 when Wheatley has played and not rushed for 100+ yards.

In addition, Wheatley's 153 rushing yards against Michigan State give him 3,419 career rushing yards, moving him past Rob Lytle (3,317 in 1973-76) into third on the all-time, career rushing yards list. Wheatley's 23 attempts against the Spartans give him 573 career attempts, placing him fourth on the all-time

career attempts list.

BIAKABUTUKA BURSTS

With his 141 rushing yards on 15 attempts against Michigan State, Biakabutuka has rushed for 534 yards in the first five games of the 1994 season, maintaining a 6.43 yards per carry and 106.8 rushing yards per game. Biakabutuka has rushed for over 100 yards in four out of the first five games of the 1994 season. In addition, "Touchdown Tim" has scored a rushing touchdown in each of the first five games of the '94 campaign and has 10 career rushing TDs in 11 career games.

COLLINS' COMPLETIONS

In completing 16 of 23 passes (.696) for one touchdown and no interceptions against the Spartans, Johnny Unitas Award candidate **Todd Collins** increased his career completion percentage rate to .650 (355 completions in 546 attempts), the highest completion percentage in Michigan history. Collins is currently tied for the Big Ten career completion percentage record held by Iowa's Chuck Long at .650 (782-1,203 in 1981-85).

Through the first five games of the 1994 campaign, Collins has completed 68.3 percent of his passes (84 completions in 123 attempts); if he maintains his current average, Collins will best his own school record set in 1992 (when he completed 64.9 percent of his passes as a backup to former 'M' quarterback Elvis Grbac). In 1993, Collins completed 63.9 percent of his passes (tied for fifth on Michigan's single season completion list).

COLLINS' YARDAGE AND 200+ GAMES

Collins' 211 yards against the Spartans give him 12 games in which he has thrown for 200 or more yards, tying him for first with Jim Harbaugh (12 in 1983-86) on the 'M' all-time list. Collins has 4,423 passing yards, the fourth best in 'M' history. Collins trails only Steve Smith (4,860 in 1980-83), Harbaugh (5,449 in 1983-86) and Grbac (6,460 in 1989-92).

With his four field goals (38, 26, 33 and 21) on four attempts against Michigan State, Remy Hamilton has now made nine consecutive field goals and 13 of his 15 attempts on the season. His four-field goal performance ties his personal best (four against Notre Dame in 1994) and ties for second on the Michigan all-time single game

field goals scored list. Just five games into the season, his 13 completions already ranks fifth best on the Michigan singleseason list. He currently maintains a .867 season completion percentage rate, which currently stands as third best in

on the Michigan single season list.

DEFENSIVE STANDOUTS

Outside linebacker Matt Dyson returned from a foot injury, seeing his first game action since the season-opener against Boston College; Dyson had one sack and two tackles....Jason Horn set a personal best for sacks with two for 20 sack yards against the Spartans. Horn also recovered a fumble...Outside linebackers Trevor Pryce and Kerwin Waldroup had one sack each... Inside linebackers Steve Morrison and Jarrett Irons led the team with eight tackles each.

AIR ATTACK

Mercury Hayes (four receptions for 96 yards) and Amani Toomer (four receptions for 67 yards) combined for a total of 163 receiving yards on the day against the Spartans. The duos' output accounted for 77.2 percent of the Wolverines passing offense. Toomer has 490 receiving yards on 23 receptions (21.30 average) and Hayes has 260 receiving yards on 17 receptions (15.3 average).
