MICHIGAN vs. WISCONSIN Post-Game Notes

SMITH JUMP-STARTS WOLVERINES

Wide receiver **Seth Smith** jump-started the Wolverine offense, returning a Wisconsin kickoff for 100 yards for a touchdown with 3:45 remaining in the first quarter. **Smith's** kickoff return for a touchdown is the longest in Michigan history, besting the previous record held by **Tyrone Wheatley** (99-yard kickoff return touchdown against Houston in 1992) and **Dennis Fitzgerald** (99-yard kickoff return touchdown against Michigan State in 1960). **Wheatley's** 99-yard touchdown dash against Houston in 1992 was the last time a Wolverine returned a kickoff for a touchdown.

WHEATLEY'S TOUCHDOWNS

With his one touchdown (24-yard rushing TD) against the Badgers, **Wheatley** has now scored a touchdown in five of the six games that he has played in during the 1994 season. **Wheatley** upped his Michigan career all-purpose touchdown record to 49 and his career rushing touchdown record to 43. **Wheatley's** 49 all-purpose touchdowns are tied for third with **Keith Byars** (49 in 1982-85) of Ohio State and his 43 rushing touchdowns tie for fifth with **Lorenzo White** (43 in 1984-87) of Michigan State on the Big Ten all-time lists. **Wheatley** has 294 career points, just 13 points shy of breaking the 'M' all-time career point scoring record held by former 'M' kicker **Mike Gillette** (307 points scored in 1985-88).

WHEATLEY ATOP CENTURY CLUB

With his 132-yard rushing performance against Wisconsin on 20 carries (6.6 yards per carry), **Wheatley** now has 19 games in which he has rushed for 100 or more yards in his career, breaking the Michigan record formerly held by **Jamie Morris** (18 in 1984-87). The Wolverines are 15-3-1 when **Wheatley** rushes for 100 or more yards.

Wheatley has 3,768 career rushing yards, just 94 rushing yards shy of passing **Butch Woolfolk** (3,861 in 1978-81) into second place on the 'M' all-time career rushing yards list. **Morris** holds the Michigan career rushing yards record, with 4,393 rushing yards in 1984-87.

COLLINS' COMPLETIONS

Despite being injured and missing part of the game against Wisconsin, senior quarterback **Todd Collins** managed to complete 14 passes on 25 attempts (.560 completion percentage) for 172 yards and one touchdown. **Collins** maintains a .645 career completion percentage rate (400 completions on 620 attempts), which is ranked first on 'M' career completion rate list.

COLLINS' YARDAGE

With his 172 passing yards against the Badgers, **Collins** has 19 games in which he has thrown for 150 or more yards, tied for second on the 'M' all-time list with **Jim Harbaugh** (19 in 1983-86). **Collins** trails only **Elvis Grbac** (23 in 1989-92) on the most career games of 150+ passing yards list.

Collins has 4,993 career passing yards, just seven yards shy of the 5,000 passing yard plateau. If **Collins** reaches 5,000 passing yards, he will become only the third Wolverine to accomplish this task. **Collins** trails only **Harbaugh** (5,449 career passing yards in 1983-86) and **Grbac** (6,460 career passing yards in 1989-92) on the 'M' all-time list.

MORRISON TACKLES 'M' LISTS

With his 10 tackles against Wisconsin, senior outside linebacker and Butkus Award finalist **Steve Morrison** increased his career tackle total to 320, the tenth largest career tackle total in Michigan history. **Morrison** needs seven more tackles to pass **Andy Moeller** (326 in 1983-86) into ninth place on the all-time list.

Morrison leads the Wolverines with 88 tackles during the 1994 season. In addition, **Morrison** has led the team in tackles in six (Notre Dame, Iowa, Michigan State, Penn State, Illinois and Wisconsin) of its eight games.

OFFENSE-LESS FIRST QUARTERS

Michigan has not scored a touchdown in the first quarter of any of its last six games. The last time the Wolverines scored a first quarter touchdown was when **Tshimanga Biakabutuka** rushed for nine-yard touchdown score at Notre Dame.

BITTERSWEET HOMECOMINGS

With Michigan's 31-19 Homecoming loss to Wisconsin, Michigan has now lost two straight Homecomings including last year's 24-21 loss to Illinois. After suffering a 24-23 setback to Iowa in 1990, Michigan has managed only two Homecoming victories in the past five years. Including this Homecoming loss, Michigan has now lost three home games this season, the most since losing to Navy, Michigan State, and Homecoming opponent Indiana in 1967. The last time Wisconsin had a victory in Ann Arbor was in 1962 when the Badgers defeated the Wolverines 34-12. The loss against the Badgers marks the first time that **Gary Moeller** has lost to the same opponent two years in a row.

RIEMERSMA REELS IN CATCHES

Tight end **Jay Riemersma** posted career highs against Wisconsin, catching eight passes for 79 receiving yards and a touchdown. His eight catches best his previous high of six catches against Illinois in 1994 and his 79 receiving yards tops his previous high of 68 receiving yards against Notre Dame in 1994. On the season, **Riemersma** has 29 catches for 300 receiving yards (10.3 yards per catch) and two touchdowns.

Head Coach Gary Moeller Quotes

On The Game In General:

"Basically I looked at the whole thing...how can we play two years versus Wisconsin without emotion. We're flat, I don't know why and I'm very disappointed. We have to find out who wants to play.

"You can't give up a long bomb and fall down on third and 'eighty-eight'"

On Collins Getting Injured and Going Out of the Game:

"No question it was a factor, that's what we've talked about all season but if you lose a tough fight it would be more of a factor. But if I played quarterback, they shouldn't have scored 31 points."

On the Defense In General:

"It concerns me when you have Tony Henderson being out hurt and lose (Matt) Dyson and (Kerwin) Waldroup but those are excuses. The people that come in, have to play...I was disappointed with the enthusiasm."

On Making Line-up Changes:

"(Do we make changes...) To punish people? No. We made adjustments and now we'll have to give others a chance. Do we change all 22? No. But we'll take at practice."

On Being Flat:

"Just playing Wisconsin should have been enough. Wisconsin, they beat us last year, that should have been enough."

On the Lack of Leadership:

"There's a lack of a lot of things when you lose, it's not one or two individuals. It's the entire senior class that has to lead."

Wisconsin Head Coach Barry Alvarez

On the Win:

"Today was a very important win for us. Maybe more important than the Rose Bowl. I'm more proud that we played this well with all of this adversity. Today we played a good team and won. "

On the Running Game:

"I didn't feel we ran that well today. I don't know but I think we had more yardage last week. We played a good team with good players, but we run better than that."

On the Team:

"The most important thing is that I got my football team back, playing the way the should, the way we used to. I'm glad we got that back."

"The most important thing from our kids today was that they showed character. They had their backs against the wall and they came through."

"We were stoked after the Rose Bowl and then we got kicked like dogs for a couple of weeks. It's nice to come out and do something no one expects."

On the Senior Class:

"I thought our seniors stepped up this week. They got a lot of stuff off their chests, they talked to the younger guys and that really helped them relax. I'm proud of my seniors, they were a big part of today's win."
