### FROM THE MICHIGAN PRESS ROOM

Head Coach Lloyd Carr:

(On the game in general...) "From my standpoint it was a great ballgame. You had to be down on the field to understand how bad the conditions were. For us it was a hell of a win. The kids bounced back (from the loss to Michigan State), I am proud of them."

(On Michigan having trouble scoring in the red zone...) "We knew going in it was going to be tough. They used the baseball tarp and it didn't cover the field completely. The tarp was on the field from the 20 to the 20, we knew the field would be hazardous inside the 20 (at both ends of the field)."

(On the defensive play in general...) "The defense played great. Under any conditions I never thought we'd hold (Mike) Alstott to 19 yards. It was a tremendous effort.

"The biggest play of the day came after we were stopped in close. The defensive coordinator (Greg Mattison) made a great call. He brought Clarence Thompson off the corner and he got the sack for the safety. It changed the complex of the game as Purdue was then forced to get a touchdown to win the game."

(On the play of several individuals...) "Ben Huff (defensive tackle) had an opportunity (playing for injured Trent Zenkewicz) and he did a good job.

"(Freshman outside linebacker) David Bowens did a heck of a job against a tough running game and a great tight end.

"Andre Weathers has done a great job on special teams the last few weeks, so we put him in on the nickel."

(On the use of Nate DeLong on the last punt, replacing Paul Peristeris...) "I thought they'd (Purdue) try to block it and Nate (DeLong) has had more experience under those circumstances. We still had plentyof field and we wanted to give the defense the best field position we could."

(More on the game...) "The kids played hard. They earned the win."

(On the offense in general...) "Are we a great offense? No. But we played hard and that is important. Everything else will take care of itself."
