# Post-Game Notes Michigan vs. Virginia

Freshman QB Scott Dreisbach hit senior Mercury Hayes in the right corner of the end zone with no time remaining to lift Michigan to an 18-17 victory over Virginia in the sixth annual Pigskin Classic at Michigan Stadium. The Wolverines rallied from a 17-0 fourth-quarter deficit to lift U-M to its greatest comeback in school history.

# GREATEST COMEBACK EVER FOR MICHIGAN

Michigan's rally from 17-0 down in the fourth quarter against Virginia was the greatest deficit ever overcome by a Michigan team. The previous top Wolverine comebacks were three 14-point rallies, most recently in 1981, when Michigan rallied from 21-7 down to beat Illinois 70-21.

### DREISBACH DYNAMITE

Freshman QB **Scott Dreisbach** made a record-breaking debut in his first game leading the Wolverines. Dreisbach passed for a Michigan-best 372 yards on 27 completions out of a record 52 attempts. The previous Wolverine record for yards in a game was held by Todd Collins against Minnesota in 1994. In 1966, Dick Vidmer attempted a then-record 47 passes against Michigan State.

### HOW ABOUT HAYES

Michigan senior wide receiver **Mercury Hayes** is on the rise in the record books after a record-setting performance against the Cavaliers. Hayes caught seven passes for a career-best 179 yards and a touchdown. The 179 yards tied for the fourth-best single-game receiving total. As a result, Hayes moved up to 12th on the U-M career receiving list with an even 1,400 yards. Hayes' previous top receiving day came in 1993, when he amassed 127 yards against Houston. His 43-yard reception in the fourth quarter also tied career high, matching a 43-yard catch against Minnesota in 1994.

### TOOMER IN TRIPLE DIGITS

With a four-yard reception on the first pass of the game, Michigan senior wideout **Amanl Toomer** reached the century mark for career receptions. Toomer, who came into the season tied for No. 7 on the U-M career receptions list with 99 (tied with Jamie Morris, 1984-87), caught five passes for 36 yards and now ranks 6th on the all-time list (104). Greg McMurtry is No. 5 with 111. Toomer now has 1,935 career receiving yards, good for fifth on the all-time list. Next up is Derrick Alexander (1989-93, 1,977 yards).

### 123 AND COUNTING

The Pigskin Classic crowd of 101,444 extended Michigan's streak of consecutive 100,000-plus crowds to 123 games. It was the sixth-smallest crowd since the streak began on Nov. 8,1975, and marked the first time the Wolverines have had a non-sellout since Nov. 9, 1991, when 102,087 saw U-M take on Northwestern. Still, the attendance more than tripled the average count for the first six Pigskin games (34,000-plus) held in Anaheim, Ca.

## BREAKING FREE

Virginia tailback **Tiki Barber's** 81-yard TD run in the third quarter was the fifth-longest run from scrimmage ever against Michigan and the first over 80 yards since Darrell Thompson ran 98 yards against the Wolverines on Nov. 7, 1987 at Minneapolis. In Virginia's record books, Barber's run was the second best all-time, tying Tommy Vigorito, who ran the same distance against North Carolina State in 1979,

### MICHIGAN FIRSTS

Senior Chuck Winters' third-quarter fumble recovery was the first of his Michigan career.

Several Michigan players made their U-M debuts against Virginia, including winning QB Scott Dresibach. Also earning their first playing time were redshirt freshmen Tyrone Butterfield, Jon Jansen, Jerame Tuman, Rasheed Simmons, Juaquin Feazell, Marcus Ray, Eric Mayes, Clint Copenhaver, Todd Brooks, Mark Campbell, PK Jay Feely, Sam Sword, Chris Singletary. Also playing were true freshmen Clarence Williams, David Bowens and Charles Woodson.
