## **NINTH LARGEST CROWD IN MICHIGAN HISTORY WATCHES WIN**

Today's announced crowd of 106,381 was the ninth largest in Michigan history and marked the 134th consecutive game that Michigan drew more than 100,000 fans at Michigan Stadium. The Michigan attendance record was set on Nov. 20, 1993, when 106,867 fans packed Michigan Stadium to see 'M' defeat OSU, 28-0.

## **WOLVERINES WIN IN THE WHITE STUFF**

Today's game kicked off with snow flurries, the 15th time since 1947 that Michigan has played in the snow. Michigan is now 8-7 in these contests, eight of which occurred in Ann Arbor and all of which have been played in November.

## **HAMILTON TIES FIELD GOAL MARK**

With his 44-yard field goal in the fourth quarter this afternoon, senior placekicker **Remy Hamilton (Boca Raton, FL)** tied the Michigan record for career field goals. Hamilton tied the Michigan record of 57 held by **Mike Gillette (1985-88)**. Hamilton's eight points on the day gives him 258 for his career and moved him into third place on the Michigan points scored list, passing **J.D. Carlson (254, 1988-91)**.

## **IRONS ICES 400TH INDIVIDUAL**

Senior co-captain **Jarrett Irons (The Woodlands, TX)** collected his 400th career tackle in the first half against Michigan State. Irons recorded eight tackles (six solo, two assists) this afternoon for a career total of 406, placing him 4th on the Michigan all-time tackles list.

## **OVER THE HILL**

Michigan's back-to-back wins of 44-10 over Minnesota and 45-29 over Michigan State marked the first time since 1992 that the Wolverines scored 40 points in consecutive games. In 1992, Michigan mauled Houston (61-7) and Iowa (52-28) in back-to-back wins.

## **RAY BRIGHTENS END OF BOTH HALVES**

Junior cornerback **Marcus Ray (Columbus, OH)** set up Michigan's third touchdown of the first half. Ray picked off a Todd Schultz pass at the Michigan 47-yard line and returned the ball 35 yards to the Michigan State 18-yard line. Ray's first interception of his career set up a 15-yard pass from **Scott Dreisbach** to **Jerame Tuman** two plays later to give the Wolverines a 21-10 lead. Ray made his second interception midway through the fourth quarter, recording a 16-yard return.

## **DREISBACH DOLES OUT FOUR TOUCHDOWN PASSES**

Junior/sophomore quarterback **Scott Dreisbach (Mishawaka, IN)** threw four touchdown passes against Michigan State, tying a Michigan record compiled eight other times by six individuals. First accomplished in 1983 by Steve Smith, the last Wolverine to throw for four touchdown passes in a game was **Brian Griese** vs. Minnesota, Oct. 26, 1995.

## **MORE TOUCHDOWN TIDBITS**

**Charles Woodson's** 26-yard touchdown reception was the first receiving touchdown of his career...Michigan scored three touchdowns in a span of 2:09 near the end of the first half...**Jerame Tuman's** two touchdown receptions were a career high and the most in a game by a Michigan receiver this season...**Chris Howard's** two scores marked his second consecutive multiple touchdown game (third of the season).

## **STREAKING ACROSS THE FIELD**

Michigan improved to 7-0 when losing the coin toss in 1996...Michigan has won eight straight games when losing the coin toss dating back to last year's Ohio State game...The Wolverines won their eighth straight game at Michigan Stadium (the most since a nine-game winning streak from 1991-92)...The win guaranteed Michigan's 12th consecutive winning season overall...Dreisbach recorded his sixth straight 150-yard passing game.

Michigan State wide receiver Derrick Mason established career highs in both receptions(10) and receiving yards (151). His previous best in reception yardage was 150 vs. Purdue in 1995. Mason's 10 receptions is good for a third place tie on Michigan State's single game receptions record list, while his receiving yards was the 12th best in Michigan State history.

Quarterback Todd Schultz completed 24 passes in 45 attempts this afternoon, both career highs. His game totals rank 11th and tied for third, respectively, on the Spartans' single game record list.

Sedric Irvin's four-yard touchdown run in the third quarter was his 14th touchdown of the season. He has at least one touchdown in each of his last six games. Irvin ranks eighth on Michigan State's single season touchdown list (14) and eighth in rushing touchdowns (12). His 84 points this year also ranks eighth on Michigan State's season scoring record.

Michigan's Chris Howard ran for 100 yards vs. the Spartans this afternoon, the first time an individual had rushed for 100 yards vs. Michigan State this season.

Derrick Mason's 44-yard kickoff return in the third quarter was the season long by a Michigan State player and his 11th career kick return of more than 40 yards.

**FROM THE MICHIGAN LOCKER ROOM:**

**HEAD COACH LLOYD CARR**

(On ...) "I thought the biggest play of the game was Marcus Ray intercepting the ball. I thought our coaching staff did a great job. Our kids executed and it was hard struggle because Michigan State is an excellent football team. It was a hard fought game but there were some plays in there towards the end of the (first) half that turned the momentum in our way and we held on for the victory."

(On the victory in general...) "There is something about losses that stay with you forever and they affect you in a lot of ways that people don't know, but this is a great win for Michigan."

(On the rivalry...) "I tried to tell our kids from Sunday when we met for the first time that it was something that we wanted very badly and there wasn't any question in my mind that we played hard and we played with great intensity. We have to enjoy it. It is a great rivalry. There would be a lot of hype during the week. There would be a lot written about the coaches and the quarterbacks, and the offensive lines and comparing them. I told them the key is don't be distracted by all the hype, concentrate on what we are trying give you as a game plan and then mentally prepare yourself to give a great effort on Saturday afternoon and I think that's what we did."

(On the defense...) "I thought our defensive coaches did a great job because they were able to hit (Todd) Schultz a number of times. We didn't sack him at all, but we did pressure him and we played a good zone coverage. We didn't give them the big one. Pressure had a big impact. We got some turnovers, which were big."

(On the running game...) "I thought Fred Jackson came up with some great offensive calls. Those two touchdowns at the end of the (first) half that broke the game open, the pass to Tuman and then the pass to Woodson, those were great calls and I give him all the credit. Mike DeBord and Bobby Morrison and all those guys in the running game did a tremendous job. We have one heck of an offensive line. I think Chris Howard again showed kind of back that he is capable of being."

**JUNIOR/SOPHOMORE RIGHT TACKLE JON JANSEN**

(On the drive after State took a 10-7 lead...) "We had come out in the first drive and established the run and I think there were a couple of drives in there when we didn't move the ball and we thought we had to come out and run the ball right at them again and just take it to them."

**JUNIOR RUNNING BACK CHRIS HOWARD**

(On the drive to take the lead before the end of the first half...) "I think that was an important drive for us because normally we don't want to get down on ourselves. We were down 10-7 which in our minds didn't mean anything. We've been down before but we just had to keep our composure and pound the ball at them."

(On patience...) "I think that's the key especially in this type of offense in college football today. You have linebackers who are able to run as fast as running backs these days so I think it is a key to have patience once you get to the line of scrimmage to make sure you are not over-running something that could possibly be a big play."

**JUNIOR/SOPHOMORE STRONG SAFETY MARCUS RAY**

(On his first interception...) "Vance Bedford teaches us to play our assignments based on the situation so it was a second and short, a two-minute situation. They were trying to throw short quick passes, trying to get down the field and I knew that whenever Todd Schultz looked at his first target, that is where he was going to go with the ball. So when he looked, I just took off."

(More on the interception...) "Our coaches come up with a game plan every week and Vance Bedford just teaches us to take advantage of opportunities. So I saw, just by studying film, that whenever they run that type of play, that's where the ball was going."

**SENIOR CENTER ROD PAYNE**

(On the protecting Scott Dreisbach...) "He did get hit a couple of times but for the most part we worked on their blitzes a lot and on their twist and stunts so I think as an offensive line we can be proud of the victory we had today."

**Derrick Mason on the Spartans attitude at the half:**

"We were still up. We had 30 minutes left and we got the ball back to start the second half. We felt we could go down and score. I felt our offense was good enough to score 21 points in the second. Even with three minutes left, we felt we could win the game."

**Derrick Mason on the pass in the end on which he was ruled out of bounds:**

"I thought I made the play and so did everybody else, but everybody else ain't playing the game. The refs make the call and that was the call."

"I'll look at the replay. If I had a touchdown, I'll call the NC2A. No, the ref had the call and he made the call."

**Head Coach Nick Saban:**

"I was very disappointed in the outcome, but I give a lot of credit to Michigan. Obviously the turnovers in the last two minutes of the half were the big difference in the game ... I'm proud of the way we played."

"Their players played well. We couldn't come back from five turnovers, but I feel we also played well overall today."

**Saban on the interception leading to Michigan's first touchdown:**

"We were gonna run and see if we got a first down. We got a penalty and we went into our two-minute offense ... I would do it all over again."

**Saban on the fumble by Morris on the kickoff:**

"He should have fair caught the ball. We practice fair catching the ball."

**Senior defensive lineman Chris Smith:**

"This loss hurts more than any in my career."

**Quarterback Todd Schultz on the Woodson interception in the end zone:**

"It was just a bad read. It was an out and up to Nigea Carter and the corner took a deep drop. I shouldn't have thrown it. I didn't read the defense fast enough."

**Senior center Matt Beard on losing in his last game against Michigan:**
