Michigan vs. Notre Dame

Game Notes

ATTENDANCE STREAK CONTINUES

With today's attendance of 106,508 fans, Michigan extended its streak of games with 100,000 or more fans to 138. The crowd ranks as the largest of the season and the sixth-largest Michigan Stadium crowd. It marks the second largest crowd to ever watch a game between the Wolverines and Irish behind the series mark of 106,851 set on Sept. 11, 1993.

SWORD STRIKES AGAINST IRISH

Senior linebacker **Sam Sword** (*Saginaw, MI*) had a career game against Notre Dame. Sword collected a career-high 15 tackles, 13 of them solo (two assists) with one tackle for a loss (one yard) on his way to earning the ABC Player of the Game honors.

QUICK STRIKE

Junior wideout **Tai Streets** (*Matteson, IL*) hauled in his first touchdown of the season, a 41-yard catch and run from **Brian Griese** (*Miami, FL*). Both of Michigan's passes on the scoring drive went to Streets (15 and 41 yards), as U-M tied the score just 24 seconds into the second half. The touchdown was Streets's third of his career.

MR. WOODSON

Charles Woodson (*Freemont, OH*) had his usual All-American game against Notre Dame. The junior was on the field for 88 plays (77 defensive, 7 special teams, 4 offensive). Notre Dame only threw six of their 27 passes in Woodson's direction. Further, Charles returned two punts for 29 yards.

HENDRICKS SAVES THE DAY

Freshman free safety **Tommy Hendricks** (*Houston, TX*) bailed the U-M defense out. With Michigan nursing a seven-point lead, Notre Dame drove inside the Wolverines 10-yard line before Hendricks picked off a Powlus attempt into the endzone. The interception was Hendricks's second of the season.

DRIVER'S FIRST

Notre Dame freshman runningback **Tony Driver** (*Louisville, KY*) recorded his first career touchdown, a 2-yard run with 18 seconds left in the first half. The run was only Driver's seventh career carry. The freshman's run gave the Irish a 14-7 halftime lead, the first time they have lead at the half this season (tied Georgia Tech 10-10).

ROUGH START

Notre Dame is mired in a three-game losing streak for the first time since 1987 when they dropped their last two regular season games and then fell in the Cotton Bowl to Texas A&M. It is the first time the Irish have lost three straight regular season games since 1985. It also marks the first time since a 1-4 start in 1986 that the Irish have started a season 1-3.

IRISH SOLVE WOLVERINES FIRST QUARTER DEFENSE

Before Notre Dame quarterback **Ron Powlus** (*Berwick, PA*) hit **Bobby Brown** (*Lauderhill, FL*) on a 15-yard touchdown pass, the Michigan defense had not allowed a touchdown in the opening quarter for 27 consecutive games. The score was also the first touchdown scored against the Wolverines all season.

MISCELLANEOUS NOTES

Michigan's victory over Notre Dame marked the 20th win of Head Coach **Llyod Carr's** career ... **Jay Feely** (*Odessa, FL*) banged three of Michigan's four kickoffs through the endzone. He has accomplished the feat five times on the season (and at least once in each game) ... **Aaron Shea's** (*Ottawa, IL*) 10-yard reception late in the third quarter marked his first catch of the season ... Notre Dame linebacker **Lamont Bryant's** (*Gerogetown, SC*) fumble recovery was the first of the season for the Irish and second of Bryant's career ... Driver's 49-yard kickoff return marked the longest of the season by an Irish player this season ... **Ron Powlus's** first quarter completion to **Malcom Johnson** is the longest by a Notre Dame wide receiver this year (34 yards).

(On the game overall ...)

"I want to commend Notre Dame's players. They gave a tremendous effort, as we knew they would. The difference was a tremendous job by our defense. It was a credit to our kids. It was a heck of a win for us. We have to take care of the ball."

(On the decision to run on fourth-and-three at the end of the game ...)

"I was concerned of a blocked punt or a bad snap and (Ron) Powlus has the arm to throw it 60 yards. I didn't want to give him the ball. I thought it (the run) was a better call. Notre Dame had no time-outs and had its punt return unit in (the game)."

(On the offensive spark at the start of the second half ...)

"We threw effectively on first down to open the second half."

(On the play of Brian Griese for his first three games ...)

"He is as underrated as anyone could be. He has matured ... he assumes leadership through hard work, and a commitment to his teammates ... He is a stellar competitor. He executes the offense."

(On Notre Dame's 98-yard drive to take a 14-7 halftime lead ...)

"It was demoralizing. (Jason) Vinson had a great punt that put them inside the five, and we were looking to get field position. But our tackling wasn't sharp and (Notre Dame) gave us some new wrinkles. (Autry) Denson ran hard. They are a good football team."

(On the emotion of the win ...)

"When we went in (to the locker room) down at the half, there was some doubt for a few moments, but this fall we had addressed that the mark of an outstanding team is that it is prepared to do what it needs to do."

Senior Quarterback Brian Griese

(On the finish of the game ...)

"It was a win and that's all. It was a great game, a great series, but offensively, we cannot play like that."

(On Notre Dame ...)

"I thought they played their hearts out. We prepared like they were going to come in and play their best game, and that's exactly what they did. They were not going to give up ... They are definitely better than a one and three team."

"I think they are a good football team, they have guys who play tough. I don't care if you have talent or not, they played tough. That's what that team was—tough."

(On not being on the field for Notre Dame's last possession ...)

"I wished I was out on the field, but I have confidence in every guy out there. I think that's what this team has, and maybe what's different than the teams we've had in the past is that each guy trusts the next guy. It's a good feeling."

(On the game in general ...)

"We (the offense) didn't do what we were supposed to do. I just give the credit to the defense for the win."

"I'm glad this game came down to the fourth quarter because you find something out about your team. I think this game will help us win tight games down the road."

(On the team and the season ...)

"We think we have something special, but each and every guy realizes that there is a long road ahead. Down the line—Michigan State, Penn State, Ohio State, Iowa—those games you have to play perfectly."

"You've got to give Michigan credit, they came back in the second half and we knew they would. You have to give us credit too. We hung on after the Michigan onslaught early in the second half ... They had two quick touchdowns in the second half and took the momentum. We had some really great opportunities to win the football game."

(On struggling of offense in the second half)

"Offensively we came back with a couple of penalties we bogged down, they made it 21-14. We were right there. Our defense forced three turnovers. Our offense couldn't get any points from them."

(On the failed fourth down running attempt late in the game)

"We went with an unbalanced line. We put both tackles over and checked off. It was extremely loud. I'm not sure the communication was there."

(On running the ball on the fourth down play)

"I really think we need to get a yard and a half to win the football game."

(On reflecting on the game)

"Let's be honest when we look at why we lost. Did Michigan really beat us or did we beat ourselves? Certainly you look at the second half with the kicking game, the first kick off we don't kick the ball where we wanted to. We have a four year starter get beat in man coverage for a 45-yard touchdown ... On offense we had three turnovers for second chance situations and we don't get any points in the second half."

Quarterback Ron Powlus:

"It's a tough loss. It's a tough feeling. We came over here. We thought it was going to be a good day. We feel like we had great effort, especially in the first half. We wish some things would go differently, we wish we could have taken advantage of some of those opportunities. Unfortunately, we didn't do that and we are walking away with a loss."
