Filling the "Big House"

The Michigan-Eastern Michigan game drew a crowd of 110,438 fans, the second-largest crowd in Michigan Stadium and NCAA history (111,012 vs. Syracuse, Sept. 12, 1998). The Wolverines have drawn over 100,000 fans for 144 consecutive home games, a streak that dates back to the 1975 season.

Carr Wins 30th Career Game

University of Michigan head coach **Lloyd Carr** claimed his 30th career victory as the Wolverines defeated Eastern Michigan, 59-20. Carr, who began his collegiate coaching career as an assistant coach at EMU (1976-77), reached the 30-win plateau in his 40th career game as a coach. His record currently stands 30-10.

Jansen Makes 40th Consecutive Start

With today's start at right tackle, senior captain **Jon Jansen** (Clawson, Mich.) started his 40th consecutive game along the offensive trenches for the Wolverines. Jansen becomes the 12th player in school history to make at least 40 career starts and the first since Rod Payne and Jarrett Irons in 1996. The school record of 49 starts is held by former defensive tackle Mark Messner (1985-88), U-M's all-time leader in sacks.

A-Train Back on Track

Sophomore tailback **Anthony Thomas** (Winnfield, La.) recorded his first 100-yard game of the season and third of his career. Thomas gained 117 yards on 15 carries with three touchdowns. Thomas accounted for Michigan's first drive as he carried the ball on all four plays (69 yards), ending in a two-yard TD plunge. Thomas' second score, a two-yard run, capped the Wolverines second drive. His third TD came on a four-yard run midway through the third quarter. Thomas has eight career rushing touchdowns.

Trifecta

This is the third straight game that a Wolverine has rushed for 100 yards, and each time has been by a different player. **Clarence Williams** (Detroit, Mich.) rushed for 114 yards in the season opener at Notre Dame (Sept. 5), **Walter Cross** (Fort Washington, Md.) gained 104 yards against Syracuse and Thomas had 117 yards in today's game.

First Play Peterson

Sophomore cornerback **William Peterson** (Uniontown, Pa.) made an immediate impact on defense for the Wolverines, intercepting a pass and returning it 51 yards for a touchdown on his first play of the season. It was Peterson's first career interception and first career touchdown. The play was Michigan's first return for a touchdown since **Andre Weathers'** (Flint, Mich.) interception return in last season's Ohio State game. Peterson missed the first two games of the 1998 season due to injuries.

Touchdown Terrell

True freshman **David Terrell** (Richmond, Va.) caught his first career touchdown pass on a 13-yard slant pattern from **Tom Brady** (San Mateo, Calif.) with 2:33 left in the third quarter. He added a second TD reception early in the fourth quarter on a 32-yard pass from **Drew Henson** (Brighton, Mich). Terrell ended the game with four receptions for 65 yards and was named ESPN-Regional's Player of the Game.

Defense

The Michigan defense, which had two turnovers in its first two games, created four turnovers against Eastern Michigan. **Anthony Jordan** (Jersey City, N.J.), **DeWayne Patmon** (San Diego, Calif.), **William Peterson** and **Andre Weathers** all had interceptions in the game. Peterson's pick came 3:43 into the second quarter. Weathers collected his first INT of the season (third of his career) came 3:30 into the game. Weathers returned the play 24 yards, setting up Michigan's second touchdown. Patmon's interception, the second of his career (first of the season), set up the Wolverines' fifth TD. Jordan picked off a pass early in the fourth quarter and returned it 32 yards for a touchdown. It was Jordan's first career interception and touchdown. This is only the second time the Wolverines have returned two interceptions for touchdowns in a game (Dave Debich, 23 yards, and Tom Seabron, 40 yards, against Northwestern on Oct. 18, 1975).

True Freshman Firsts ...

True freshman kicker **Hayden Epstein** (Cardiff, Calif.) made his collegiate debut on Michigan's first kickoff. Eastern Michigan was limited to 35 yards on its three returns, with seven touchbacks. EMU's best starting field position off a kickoff was the 23-yard line. Epstein collected his first collegiate point on a PAT late in the fourth quarter. Freshman tailback **Justin Fargas** (Encino, Calif.) scored his first collegiate touchdown on a one-yard run in the fourth quarter. He carried the ball seven times for 34 yards, including a career-long 18-yard rush.

Michigan Head Coach Lloyd Carr

"We improved as a team. We played a lot of young people because we're banged up. We're getting a lot of guys some experience."

You cannot have those types of mental errors regardless of who you are playing. I was happy with our passing game, especially the way we threw the ball in the flat and dinked it around. We even went downtown successfully a couple of times."

(On the performance of Walt Church ...)

"Walt was good and after he made a couple of unforced errors early in the game he settled down and played well. He threw the ball in the flat, real well, and also threw the deep ball on the money. Walt gets better every week. He plays with good poise, has a strong arm and showed he can play at this level."

(On Eastern Michigan's increased confidence throughout the game ...)

"Our defense gained some confidence late in the first half after we held Michigan to a couple of three and out series'. On offense, we put together a couple long drives for scores and that helped our confidence as well. If you move the ball 80 yards on Michigan's defense, you know you are doing some things right."

(On the play of Eastern Michigan's offensive line ...)

"Our offensive line gave Walt all day to throw and that is key in our system. Even when we went to a seven-step drop and threw the ball down field we had excellent pass protection.
