SO FAR	BEGINNING WITH THIS LESSON
-parts of speech: pronoun (interrogative, demonstrative)	-part of speech: relative pronoun
-sentences may have clauses which are not on an equal level. So, these have been dependent adverbial clauses.	-some dependent clauses are <i>adjectival</i> clauses -some dependent clauses are <i>noun</i> clauses
-adjectives modify nouns	-some relative clauses are adjectival modifiers of nouns
-adjectives and pronouns may function as syntactic equivalents of nouns, e.g., substantive adjectives	-dependent clauses function as syntactic equivalents of nouns (noun clauses)
-subordinators are conjunctions	-subordinators include relative pronouns
