-statements are expressed directly	-statements can be expressed indirectly
-noun clauses, finite	-noun clauses, non-finite
-case uses of the accusative	-a new case use of the accusative
-infinitives have occurred in two syntactic settings	-two new constructions using infinitives
-certain verbs raise the expectation of a complementary infinitive	-two new lists of verbs which raise expectations of either an objective infinitive construction or an indirect statement
-infinitive is metaphrased with a non-finite English expression, either as the infinitive “to ____” or as the gerund “____ing”	-an infinitive in indirect statement is translated as a finite verbs, not as an infinitive
