SO FAR	BEGINNING WITH THIS LESSON
-parts of speech: noun, pronoun, verb, infinitive, adverb, preposition, coordinating conjunction	-part of speech: adjective
-words in a sentence are kernel items, connectors, or adverbial modifiers	-some words are adjectival modifiers
-nouns are identified by case and number	-add <i>gender</i> to identification of nouns, adjectives, and pronouns
-a modifier raises the expectation of a head	-an adjectival modifier raises the expectation of a noun-head
-gapping: identical items may be gapped	-gapping may occur with the noun-heads of adjectives (see BS5.4)
