

Impact of Submissions In Progress at the time of Release 2.0

All submissions will display in the new 2.0 system look and feel. For questions that have been moved, responses to those questions will be moved as well. Submission ID numbers will stay the same.

The following chart lists types of submissions that may have study team or committee member as a result of the upgrade to 2.0:

Human Subjects Application	Presubmission	12.1 not yet answered or answered “no”	Submission will follow path for Application Type selected prior to 2.0. Submissions will require responses to some additional questions. It is suggested that study teams run Error Check to make sure they have responded to all required questions.
Human Subjects Application	Presubmission	12.1 answered “yes”	<b>Submission Application Type will change to Exempt</b> , study teams will be required to complete section 5-3. <b>Note:</b> a communication will be sent to study teams in this situation to let them know they will need to complete section 5-3.

Human Subjects Amendment	Presubmission, Approved with Contingencies, Changes Requested	N/A	Submissions will require responses to some additional questions. It is suggested that study teams run Error Check to make sure they have responded to all required questions.
Human Subjects Reviewer Checklist	Any	Checklist was created prior to 2.0	The section number listed on the reviewer checklist may not be correct if the corresponding question has moved in the study application. It will display correctly for checklists created after Release 2.0.
IBC Registration	Presubmission, Changes Requested	N/A	Submissions will require responses to some additional questions.
