J. C. Penny's will be sponsoring the evening by providing many of the patterns and fabric used by Dames to make their own outfits which they will be modeling.


Refreshments will be provided by the Sewing and Knitting and Drama Groups. Susie Bess will be doing the commentating for the evening.
