

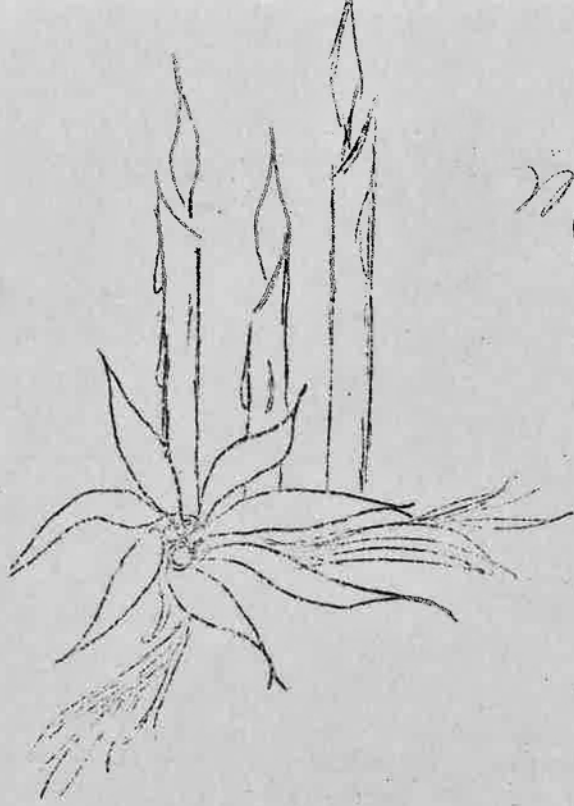

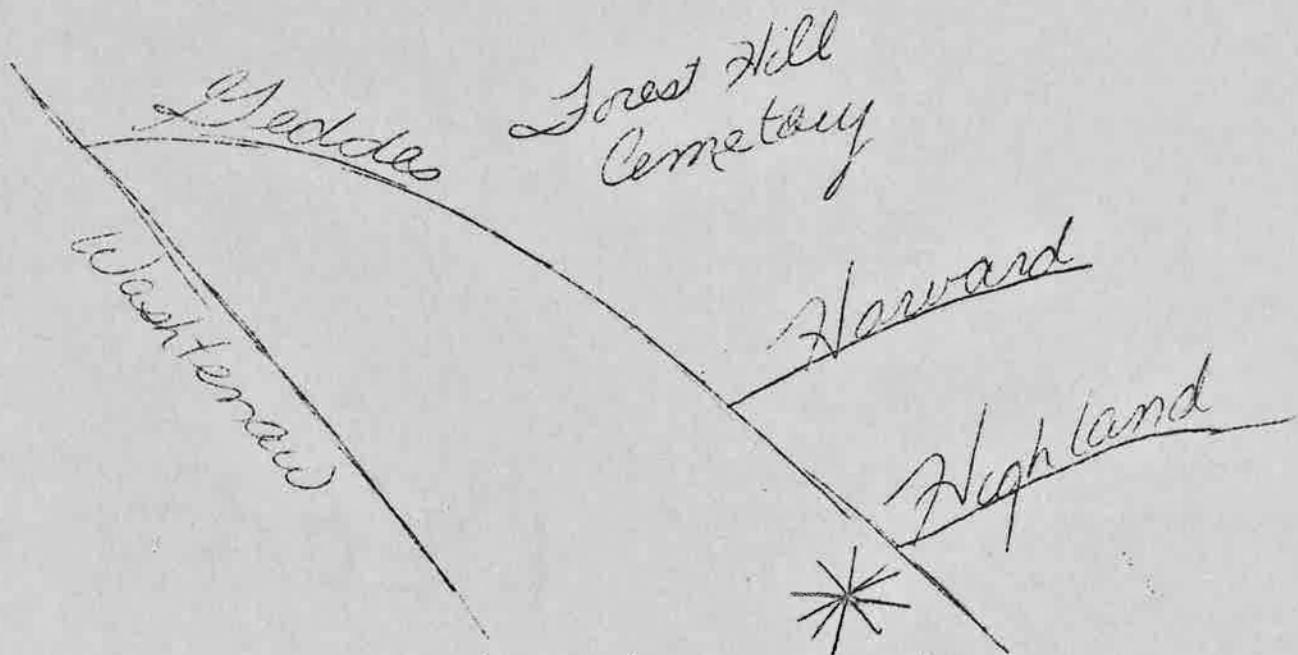

We will make stocking dolls and sock ducks (suitable for children's gifts), a Christmas wreath, and felt Christmas stockings. You may make any or all of the projects, or just come to see how they are made and make your own at home. Also, feel free to bring your own knitting or sewing project and

join us for a social evening. Please bring along any cut gifts or decorations you have made so all of us can benefit from your ideas.

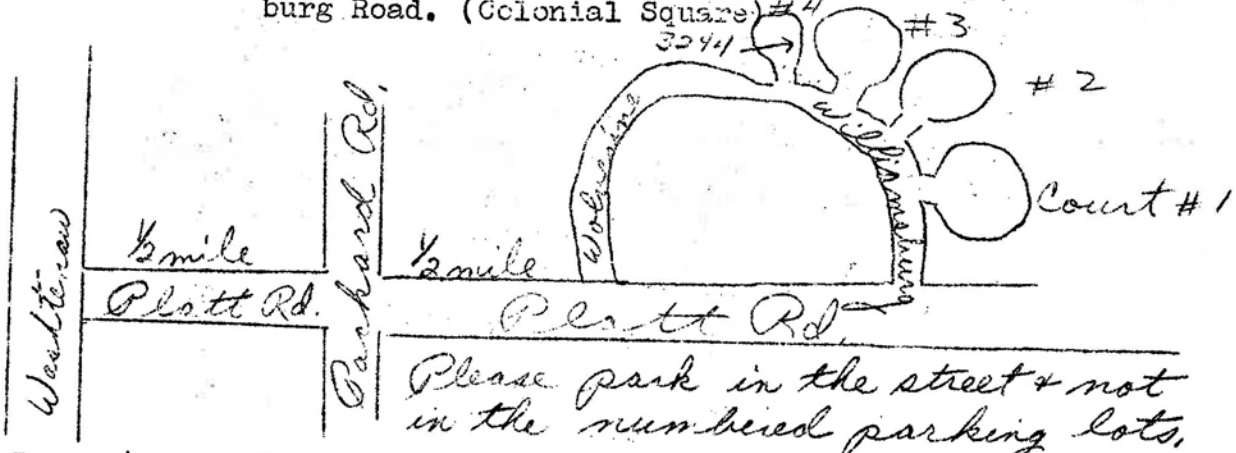
The materials needed for the projects are:

1. Stocking doll-- One man's white cotton stocking, about size 11. (These are the stockings available at the dime store for about 25¢ a pair.) Strong white thread, yarn for doll's hair, stuffing for doll body, scraps of fabric for clothes.
 2. Sock ducks-- Wool or orlon stretch socks; one size 8-9½ for mother duck; two size 6-7½ for baby ducks. Buy the socks in whatever color you want the ducks to be. Scraps of felt for feet, wings, beaks, eyes. Scraps of fabric for bonnets. Thread to match socks. Stuffing for bodies.
 3. Felt Christmas stocking-- Piece of felt 18" x 20" or piece large enough to make whatever size stocking you want. Felt scraps, sequins, jingle bells, tinsel, or whatever trim you want to put on the stocking.
 4. Burlap star flower wreath-- Three pieces of nylon net 18" wide and two yards long, matching thread. Wire ring or styrofoam ring to stabilize wreath. Total of about 44-50 four-inch squares of burlap in the colors you desire star flowers to be. Felt scraps to make flower centers, glue.
