# The University of Michigan Multicultural Greek Council Awards

The Multicultural Greek Council established this awards system with the intent of rewarding chapters and individuals that excel in specified areas.

## Chapter Awards

The following awards will be presented to chapters exhibiting excellence in scholastic achievement, involvement in MGC and the greater Greek community, outstanding leadership, integrity and dedication.

The following awards require an application:

- Chapter of the Year
- Campus Involvement Award
- Chapter Program of the Year
- Cultural Program of the Year
- Community Service Award

The following award will also be given, but no application is required:

- Highest Chapter GPA

There is no minimum or maximum number of Chapter Awards for which a chapter can or must apply.

## Individual Achievement Awards

The following awards will be presented to individuals exhibiting excellence in scholastic achievement, outstanding leadership, integrity, dedication, and most importantly, involvement within the respective chapter, MGC and the greater Greek community. Individuals are nominated for these awards by members of the MGC Executive Board, members of the Greek community, or by members within the nominated individual's chapter. Once nominated, the individual will receive a brief application to fill out.

- Outstanding Male of the Year
- Outstanding Female of the Year
- Outstanding New Member of the Year (Note: This award will be given to two individuals and only those initiated in 2009 qualify)

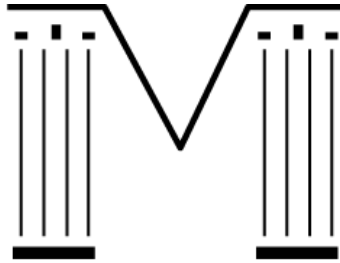
