- ◆ 36-Hole Stroke Play Competition Qualifier on July 26th & 27th. Players will be divided into flights. The top eight finishers in each flight will qualify for the match play finals on August 9th & 10th. The Matthaei Medal Champion will be awarded to the top finisher after the stroke play qualifier. The Men's Club Champion will be determined after the match play competition is complete.
- ◆ Open to any eligible golfer of Radrick Farms (Season-Pass Holders, Matthaei Club Members, President's Club Members, and University of Michigan Faculty and Staff).
- ◆ Awards and gift certificates will be awarded to the top finishers.
- ◆ All players must have a U.S.G.A. handicap.
- ◆ Should inclement weather cancel a round during the qualifier, it will be reduced to an 18 hole qualifier.
- ◆ The Previous Season's Club Champion receives an automatic berth as the top seed in match play.
