POLICY REMINDERS

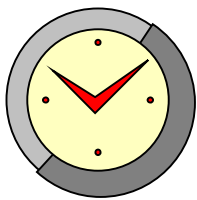
Junior Play:

- Children must be at least 16 years of age to be on the golf course. Be considerate of other golfers by not holding up play.
- Any child under the age of 16 must adhere to the following rules:
 - (1) Pass a written test.
 - (2) Cannot make tee times.
 - (3) May not play before 3:00 p.m. on the weekends or holidays unless the child can meet playing eligibility requirements (see clubhouse manager).
 - (4) Must be accompanied by an adult who is an eligible golfer and takes full responsibility for the child's safety and actions while on the golf course.

Riding Carts: For your own safety, golf carts must be returned at least 15 minutes prior to dark. Thank you.

Golf Instructional Offerings

Individual Lessons

For those who prefer to work one-on-one. Learn or review basics of grip, aim/alignment, stance/posture and balance. Good fundamentals applied to your natural swing motion will make the game more fun and rewarding.

Individual Lessons

½-hour lesson at the range, short game area or putting green. Cost: \$35

Individual Lesson Series

Customized to fit where you are and where you want to be. Series includes (4) half-hour range lessons and a 9-hole playing lesson. Cost: \$130

Group Lessons

Make up your own group of 2-4 players, compare your calendars and book a 1-hour lesson time. Each person in the group works on his/her own interests and needs.

Group Lessons (2 to 4 players)

One hour lesson. Each group decides if their lesson will be at the range, short game area or putting green. Cost: \$30 per person

Group Lesson Series (2 to 4 players)

A great chance for new or experienced golfers to work on how your whole game fits together rather than one "fix" at a time. Series includes (4) one hour range lessons and a 9-hole playing lesson. Cost: \$110 per person

So Everyone Can Enjoy Playing ..

- Consider continuous putting there is no need to mark and re-read every putt
- Play "ready golf" especially from the tee
- Leave your bag or cart to the rear of the green (closest to the next tee) or at least even with the pin
- Voices carry - Be aware of the proximity of others not in your group (for example, 1st tee and 10th tee, 3rd green and 4th tee, etc.)
- Limit your practice swings to 1
- Stay clear of the tee if another group is still teeing off. Move off the green but hang back a little from the next tee area
- Provided you can do so safely, walk to your ball or in its direction rather than standing next to the person hitting or sitting in the cart
- Restrain yourself from giving impromptu swing clinics on the course even if asked to do so

“Ask Paul” Corner

*Is there any out of bounds areas
on the golf course?*

Yes... but not much. The parking lot and driveway curbs are to be played as out of bounds. Also, deep in the woods on the 13th, on the right, there is an old wire fence that is considered out of bounds.

Can I play a shot out of the tall grass?

We prefer that you don't... and so do you! The new local rule this season is that any “natural” areas are to be played as a lateral hazard. This rule offers options - be sure to read your rule book. Whatever you do, **DON'T DRIVE YOUR CART** in these areas!

More importantly, these areas could be harboring all sorts of animal and plant life. You could unwittingly step into a patch of poison ivy or worse yet... a venomous snake.

*Come on... there are no
poisonous snakes in Michigan!?*

It's true, Radrick Farms Golf Course is home to Eastern Massasauga Rattle Snakes. This snake bite can be painful and can make you ill. They have been spotted on the course from the 15th hole through the 17th. Do not kill them! They are a golfer's friend as they are a natural predator of moles. Besides, they are rare and protected by the State of Michigan.
