

Expectations for KDP Leadership Council

Leadership Training:

- five mandatory sessions during your term include
 - ◊ transition session -- incoming (April)
 - ◊ first team session (April)
 - ◊ welcome back session (August)
 - ◊ wrap up session (next April)
 - ◊ transition session -- outgoing (next April)
- two elective sessions during your term are chosen from
 - ◊ "The Ins & Outs of Committee Management" (September)
 - ◊ "Actions of a Leader" (October)
 - ◊ "Keep the Motivation Going" (November)
 - ◊ "Leaving a Legacy – Goal Setting" (January)
 - ◊ "Examining Professionalism" (February)
 - ◊ "Shifting from KDP Leadership to Classroom Teaching" (March)
- a minimum of 14 hours of training are to be completed through out the year (you may choose to complete more by attending additional elective sessions)

Monthly Meetings:

- each council member will be involved with two meetings per month
 - ◊ Officers will find themselves at two meetings every month:
 - P = executive and member
 - VP = executive and program
 - T = executive and _____ (choose to be part of program, fundraising, or membership for the year)
 - S = executive and member
 - H = executive and program
 - FR = executive and fundraising
 - MC = executive and membership
 - PC = executive and program
 - ◊ Chairpersons will find themselves at the program meeting every month and then bunching their own committee meetings closer together near the time of their event:
 - KP = program and kaiser partnership
 - Skel = program and skelementary
 - FC = program and fall conference
 - BD = program and blood drive
 - MLK = program and mlk day
 - COT = program and celebration of teaching
 - LA = program and literacy alive!

Member Meetings:

- only the president and secretary are required to be at these meetings, however, it is in the leadership council person's best interest to attend them as well
