



Figure 9i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents),  $1983\text{--}84,\,\mathrm{by}$  Candidate's Party








































Figure 34i: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (Incumbents), 1995-96, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates





Figure 34c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1995-96, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates







Figure 38c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1997-98, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates






Figure 42c: Daily Number of Individual Contributions to House Candidates (General Election Challengers), 1999-2000, Difference between Democrat and Republican Candidates
